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Elder and Dependent Adult Abuse

POST Mandated Training

The goal of this training program is to educate law enforcement on how to best respond and assist elder and dependent adults. The law regarding required notifications for these investigations has changed, and this training program will highlight those changes. This training will also provide the viewer with insight on the importance of investigating and reporting abuse against elder and dependent adults.

This training meets mandates under 13515 PC and Post Regulations.

This training is for Sworn personnel: Patrol, Detectives, Patrol Specialties and Reserve Officers.

Directions: There are 2 parts to this training:

Part 1) Watch the video and complete the Student Study Guide (attached). Upon completion of the video, **print out** your Verification of Viewing Certificate. Please, **HOLD ON TO** your Certificate and completed Study Guide. **Place them BOTH in your mailbox in the WCs office, or somewhere as easily accessible (detectives/specialties)**, for the Study Guide will be reviewed during Part 2 of the training. An example of the certificate and study guide are below.

1. Sign into your Post Learning Portal
2. Search "Elder Abuse". Should be the first option: "Elder and Dependent Adult Abuse" DO NOT select "Elder and Dependent...(for Facilitators)".
3. Print out Study Guide (attached) and complete while watching video.
4. Print out Verification of Viewing Certificate. Place Certificate and Study Guide in your mailbox/easily accessible location until Part 2 of training is completed.

Part 1 is to be completed by Sunday, January 31st.

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Part 2) Attend one of the Patrol Briefings that Person Detectives will be facilitating, along with personnel from County of SB Adult Protective Services.

- The Study Guide you completed in Part 1 will be reviewed. Please bring your completed Study Guide and Verification of Viewing certificate with you to your patrol briefing.
- At the end of the briefing, **sign the roster and turn both the certificate and Study Guide into your Sergeant.** They will get them to me afterwards.

The Patrol Briefing Trainings will be held:

Tuesday, Feb. 2 (3/12 Days & Graves) and **Thursday Feb. 4th** (4/10 Days, Swings and Graves)

By completing both parts of the training, you will also receive 2 CPT Post credits.
