The current Slip Assignment Policy was adopted by the City Council by Resolution 80-113 in September, 1980. The policy has been discussed and studied by the Harbor Commission on several occasions since 1980 with no revisions being recommended to the City Council. The Harbor Commission reviewed the Grand Jury Report at its July meeting and found that the current method of handling slip transfers was equitable and reasonable and is enforced pursuant to the adopted policy. They recommend no changes be made to the existing policy.

1. That the Santa Barbara City Council should require strict compliance with current regulations or, in lieu thereof, revise current regulations to reflect current practice.
 2. Following the negotiation of a slip license, the adding of partners by the licensee should not be permitted.
