

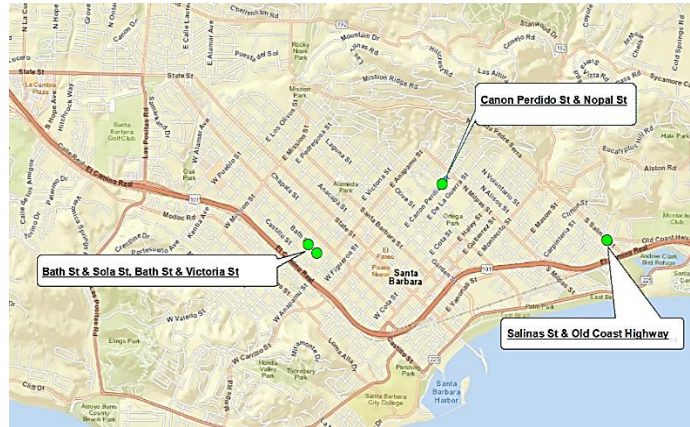


PROJECT TITLE:

Highway Safety Improvement Program Cycle 9 Pedestrian Safety Improvements Project

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) Cycle 9 Pedestrian Safety Improvements Project will construct safety enhancements at four high used intersections. The Project includes 16 new pedestrian access ramps, a pedestrian refuge island, and intersection lighting. It also includes the installation of high visibility crosswalk markings and signs to alert drivers where pedestrians frequently cross.



PROJECT BENEFITS:

The Project will improve nighttime visibility and pedestrian safety improvements on Bath and Victoria Streets, Bath and Sola Streets, Canon Perdido and Nopal Streets, and Salinas and Old Coast Highway/Punta Gorda Streets where there are high concentrations of injury traffic collisions. The Project proposes to install countermeasures that address the pattern of nighttime and pedestrian-involved collisions.
