ASSIGNED BERTHS: Fees assessed monthly per foot of boat or slip length, whichever is longer

Table listing berth fees for various slip lengths (20 to 90 feet) and other services like Fisherman's Floats and side ties.

TRANSFER FEES: Slip Permit reassignment (transfer), cost per 2 partners added to Slip Permit

Table listing transfer fees for different slip lengths (20, 25, 28-30, 35, 40, 43, 45, 50, 50 or greater).

Wait List Slip Permit Transfer Fee: 5-year sliding scale --- Request details

VISITOR BERTHS:

- Payment is due in advance. No Refunds
• Rate is per foot, length overall with a maximum stay of 28 nights
• Commercial fishing vessels remain at base rate with two current CA Dept. Fish & Wildlife tickets bi-weekly

Table showing visitor berth rates by vessel type (Recreational under/over 70 feet, Commercial fishing) and number of nights (1-14, 15-28).

WHARFAGE AND DOCKAGE:

Table listing wharfage and dockage fees for various services like Dockage, Wharfage, Hoist, Commercial Ice, and Water.

PENALTIES:

Table listing penalties for late fees, impoundment, leaving harbor, and unauthorized storage.

GATE KEYS: non-refundable

Table listing fees for Key Cards (5 maximum) at \$10.00 each, Key Fobs (5 maximum) at \$15.00 each, and Keys in excess of 5 at \$100.00 each.

PERMITS:

Table listing various permit fees including Liveaboard (\$130.00/monthly), Catamaran Beach Storage (\$250.00/season), West Beach Storage (\$300.00/yearly), West Beach Rack Storage (\$1500.00/yearly), Skiff Row (\$125.00/bi-annual - \$250.00/annual), Bicycle Locker (\$125.00/yearly), Business Activity Permit (Service \$25.00/yearly, Charter \$250.00/yearly, Late renewal fee \$25.00), Commercial Activity (Approval of Harbormaster required), Movie Feature Filming (Up to \$1200.00 per day), TV, Moving or Commercial (Up to \$1000.00 per day), Still Photography (Up to \$500.00 per day), Commercial Displays or Demonstrations (Up to \$300.00 per day, plus 20% of gross sales), and Aquatic Activities or Exhibit (\$5.00 per day).

ADMINISTRATIVE FEES:

Table listing administrative fees such as Processing Fee (\$75.00), Duplicating Fee (\$0.20/page), NSF Check Fee (\$25.00), Slip Waiting Lists (Lottery List Placement Fee \$50.00, Renewal Fee \$40.00/yearly), Liveaboard Waitlist (\$25.00/yearly), and Non-emergency Harbor Patrol services (A fee shall be charged for Harbor Patrol services except for bona fide emergencies, at a rate based on current Waterfront contract hourly service rates for manpower and equipment).

PARKING: maximum vehicle length 22' in Harbor Lot

Table listing parking permit fees and rates: Annual Parking Permits (General Permit \$125.00, Slip Permittee Permit \$125.00, Oversized Vehicle Permit \$50.00 extra), Vehicle (\$2.50/hour), Stearns Wharf (\$3.00/hour), Oversized Vehicles, 33' max length (\$4.00/hour), Boat Trailer (\$2.00/hour), and Launch Ramp Washdown (\$1.00/5 minutes).
