GENERAL INFORMATION

INTRODUCTION

The following is an updated list of plant materials recommended for use within the City of Santa Barbara El Pueblo Viejo (EPV) Landmark District. However, this list can be used throughout the City for any project seeking to use California native and Mediterranean plant material, or to install plants consistent with the City's goals for water efficiency and defensible space requirements. This list is intended only as a guideline, other plant materials may also be suitable for use.

WATER WISE PLANTS

Landscape plans must comply with Municipal Code Chapter 22.80, Landscape Design Standards for Water Conservation. Commercial properties must have **100%** water wise plants, and residential properties must have at least **80%** water wise plants. **Water wise plants** are those plants that are evaluated as needing "low" or "very low" amounts of irrigation water as defined and listed by Water Use Classifications of Landscape Species ([WUCOLS](#)) or the [Santa Barbara Addendum to WUCOLS](#).

HIGH FIRE HAZARD AREA PLANTS

Specific plants are considered to be unacceptable in the landscape due to their flammable characteristics within high fire hazard areas. See the [Wildland Fire](#) webpage for more information on defensible space requirements. The absence of a particular plant from this list does not necessarily mean it is fire resistive nor does it imply that a particular plant will be approved by the Fire Code Official for landscaping in the High Fire Hazard Area.



PLANT MATERIALS CHECKLIST

The following is a list of recommended plant materials. Although all the plants on this list are acceptable for use in EPV, not all plants on this list are water wise plants or suitable for use in the High Fire Area.

An ✓ means the plant COMPLIES; an ✗ means the plant does NOT COMPLY with the standard.

Remember: Commercial properties must be 100% water wise, and residential properties must have at least 80% of the total landscaped area (excluding hardscape) planted with water wise plants.
