<b><u>ADVISORY GROUP</u></b>	<b><u>NUMBER OF VACANCIES</u></b>
Architectural Board of Review ..... Members need not be qualified electors* of the City at the time of their appointment so long as they are qualified electors* of the County and remain so during their term. Member must be a licensed architect.	1
Arts Advisory Committee ..... May be qualified electors* of the City, or South Coast Area residents.	2
Building and Fire Code Board of Appeals ..... Members shall be residents of the City or adjoining unincorporated area of Santa Barbara County, and shall demonstrate knowledge and expertise in specialty areas governed by the construction and fire codes of the City.	5
Central Coast Commission for Senior Citizens..... Member must be a resident of the City of Santa Barbara.	1
Citizen’s Oversight Commission ..... May not hold any full-time paid office or employment in City government. One appointee must be a member of the Hospitality Community; one appointee must be a qualified elector* of the City.	2
Civil Service Commission ..... Members must be qualified electors* of the City.	1
Community Development and Human Services Committee..... Members must be qualified electors* of the County of Santa Barbara, or employees of the designated organizations. One representative from each of the following specified categories or organizations: Downtown Area Neighborhood; Business Community; Westside/Lower Westside Neighborhood; Human Services Organization; Latino Community.	5
Community Events and Festivals Committee..... Appointees may not hold any full-time paid office or employment in City government. Member must represent one of the following categories: cultural arts or business/lodging/retail industry.	3
County of Santa Barbara Library Advisory Committee ..... Must be a resident of the City.	1

\* Resident of the City of Santa Barbara who is a U.S. citizen age 18 or older.

**ADVISORY GROUP ..... NUMBER OF VACANCIES**

Creeks Advisory Committee..... 1  
 Member may be either a City or non-City resident and represent one of the following categories: have experience in ocean use (e.g. recreational user or commercial fisherman, etc.), business, environmental issues, or public at large.

Downtown Parking Committee..... 1  
 Member must be a qualified elector\* of the City or County.

Housing Authority Commission ..... 3  
 Members must represent one of the following categories: public at large; tenant receiving housing assistance from the Housing Authority, one of which must be over the age of 62. One member may be a non-City resident.

Living Wage Advisory Committee ..... 2  
 Members must represent specific categories. One member who is either an owner or a manager of a service contractor subject to the City’s Living Wage Ordinance; one member who is a representative of the public at-large.

Neighborhood Advisory Council..... 9  
 Members must be residents of the City of Santa Barbara but need not be qualified electors\*, and must be a representative of one of the following neighborhoods: Eastside, Lower Eastside, Westside; Lower Westside; West Downtown, or Laguna; or public at large.

Parks and Recreation Commission..... 1  
 Member must be a qualified elector\* of the City.  
 For Youth Interns: one youth intern shall be a high school student volunteer who resides within the Santa Barbara High School District or attends other high schools within the City limits and is nominated by the principal of the student’s high school. The student shall be and remain a student in good standing as is determined by the high school. A student that graduates shall not serve for more than three (3) months following graduation.

Rental Housing Mediation Board ..... 4  
 Members may be City or non-City residents and must meet the definitions of one of the following specific categories: Tenant Mediator member must rent or lease a dwelling with no ownership of residential properties; Landlord Mediator member must own or manage single or multiple residential units. Non-City residents must reside in a jurisdiction which contracts with the Rental Housing Mediation Program for services.

**ADVISORY GROUP ..... NUMBER OF VACANCIES**

Santa Barbara Youth Council.....	8
Members must be between the ages of 13 – 19 years old. Majority of members must be residents of the City. Other members may be residents of the County. Members must be students from the following categories: SBUSD high school students (San Marcos HS, Santa Barbara HS, and Dos Pueblos HS); representative of the public at large; student from a local private high school or independent studies; or students from a local alternative, community, or continuation high school.	
Single Family Design Board.....	1
Members must be residents of the County of Santa Barbara. Appointee must fit into the following categories: licensed architect; posses professional qualifications in fields related to architecture, including but not limited to architecture or landscape architecture, building design, structural engineering, industrial design, urban planning, or landscape contracting; or represent the public at large.	
Sister Cities Board .....	1
Member may be a resident of the adjoining areas of Santa Barbara County.	
Water Commission .....	1
Member must be a qualified elector* of the City.
