SB CLEAN ENERGY EXPANDS RESIDENTIAL EV PROGRAM

Santa Barbara Clean Energy (SBCE) has expanded its Residential Electric Vehicle (EV) Program! The program will continue to offer rebates for residential SBCE customers (which includes most City of Santa Barbara residents) who purchase or lease new or pre-owned EVs. It will now also offer rebates for installing at-home EV chargers and electrical “make-ready” work. Make-ready work includes any electrical work that occurs in preparation for (pre-wiring) or during installation of a Level 2 charger, such as an electrical panel upgrade. Qualifying EV chargers can be permanent (installed on the wall) or plug-in. They must be Level-2 chargers and network-capable. All rebates are significantly enhanced for income-qualified SBCE customers.

TODAY IS A GREAT DAY TO VERIFY YOUR VOTER REGISTRATION STATUS AND REGISTER TO VOTE!

Taking the time now to ensure your information is correct, including residence and mailing address is up to date, will help provide a smooth and simple voting process in the upcoming Presidential General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024. The last day to register to vote for the upcoming election is October 21, 2024.

A voter must be a citizen of the United States and be at least 18 years of age on election day to be eligible to vote. Voters can verify the accuracy of their voter registration, including residential and mailing addresses, at the California Secretary of State's website, SOS.CA.gov/Elections/Registration-Status or the Santa Barbara County Elections Office website at SBCVote.com. To make address and other updates to voter registration, or for eligible citizens to register to vote, go to RegisterToVote.CA.gov.

If you prefer to register to vote with a paper registration form, voter registration cards can be found in several locations including at election offices, at most post offices, and public libraries. The cards can be returned, postage-free, to the Santa Barbara County Elections Office.

¡HOY ES UN GRAN DÍA PARA VERIFICAR TU REGISTRO ELECTORAL Y REGISTRARTE PARA VOTAR!

Aprovecha este momento para asegurarte de que tu información esté actualizada, incluyendo tu dirección de residencia y de envío, lo que facilitará un proceso de votación sin contratiempos en las próximas Elecciones Generales Presidenciales, que se celebrarán el martes 5 de noviembre de 2024. La fecha límite para registrarse y poder votar en estas elecciones es el 21 de octubre de 2024.

Para votar, es necesario ser ciudadano de los Estados Unidos y tener al menos 18 años el día de las elecciones. Los votantes pueden verificar que su registro esté correcto, incluyendo las direcciones residenciales y de envío, en el sitio web de la Secretaría de Estado de California, SOS.CA.gov/Elections/Registration-Status, o en el sitio web de la Oficina de Elecciones del Condado de Santa Bárbara, SBCVote.com. Si necesitas actualizar tu dirección u otros datos en tu registro electoral, o si aún no te has registrado, visita RegisterToVote.CA.gov.

Si prefieres registrarte usando un formulario en papel, las tarjetas de registro electoral están disponibles en varios puntos, como oficinas electorales, la mayoría de las oficinas de correos y bibliotecas públicas. Estas tarjetas pueden ser enviadas, sin costo de franqueo, a la Oficina de Elecciones del Condado de Santa Bárbara.
