Arts Advisory Committee Resident of the South Coast Area of the County of Santa Barbara.	1
Building and Fire Code Board of Appeals Members shall be residents of the City or adjoining unincorporated area of Santa Barbara County, and shall demonstrate knowledge and expertise in specialty areas governed by the construction and fire codes of the City.	2
Community Development and Human Services Committee Members must be qualified electors* of the County of Santa Barbara, or employees of the designated organizations. One representative from each of the following specified categories or organizations: Disabled Community; Downtown Area Neighborhood; Business Community; Westside/Lower Westside Neighborhood; Human Services Organization; Latino Community; African American Community.	7
Community Events and Festivals Committee Appointees may not hold any full-time paid office or employment in City government. Member must represent the cultural arts.	1
County of Santa Barbara – Library Advisory Committee Member must reside within the City of Santa Barbara boundaries.	1
Downtown Parking Committee Members must be qualified electors* of the City or County.	2
Historic Landmarks Commission Member may be a qualified elector* of the City or non-City residents, and meet one of the following qualifications: licensed architect; professional architectural historian; licensed landscape architect; public at large.	1

ADVISORY GROUP NUMBER OF VACANCIES

Housing Authority Commission	1
Member must be a tenant receiving housing assistance from the Housing Authority.	
Mosquito and Vector Management District Board	1
Voter of the City, or a current member of the City Council.	
Neighborhood Advisory Council.....	6
Members must be residents of the City of Santa Barbara and must be a representative of one of the following neighborhoods: Eastside, Lower Eastside, Westside; Lower Westside; West Downtown, or Laguna; or public at large.	
Parks and Recreation Commission.....	1
<u>Youth Intern:</u> (non-voting position) one youth intern shall be a high school student volunteer who resides within the Santa Barbara High School District or attends other high schools within the City limits.	
Rental Housing Mediation Board	1
Member may be a City or non-City resident and must meet the definitions of the following specific category: Landlord Mediator member must own or manage single or multiple residential units. <u>Non-City residents must</u> reside in a jurisdiction which contracts with the Rental Housing Mediation Program for services.	
Santa Barbara Youth Council.....	2
Members must be between the ages of 13 – 19 years old. Majority of members must be residents of the City. Other members may be residents of the County. Members must be students from the following category: students from a local alternative, community, or continuation high school.	
Single Family Design Board.....	3
Appointees must fit into one of the following categories: licensed architect; possess professional qualifications in fields related to architecture, including but not limited to architecture or landscape architecture, building design, structural engineering, industrial design, urban planning, or landscape contracting; or represent the public at large. Members with professional qualifications must be residents of the County of Santa Barbara; members representing the public at large must be residents of the City of Santa Barbara.
