Access Advisory Committee Members shall be City residents and from one of the following categories: Disability Community; Architectural, Engineering, or Building Communities; or at-large.	2
Airport Commission Qualified electors* of the City or County of Santa Barbara.	2
Arts Advisory Committee Qualified electors* of the City, or resident of the South Coast area of the County; and persons with acknowledged accomplishments in the arts or demonstrate interest in and commitment to cultural and arts activities.	4
Building and Fire Code Board of Appeals Members shall be residents of the City or adjoining unincorporated areas of Santa Barbara County and shall demonstrate knowledge and expertise in specialty areas governed by the construction and fire codes of the City.	2
Civil Service Commission Qualified elector* of the City.	1
Community Development and Human Services Committee Members must be qualified electors* of the County of Santa Barbara, or employees of the designated organizations. One representative from each of the following specified categories or organizations: Disabled Community; Downtown Area Neighborhood; Latino Community; African American Community; Eastside Community.	5
Community Events and Festivals Committee Appointees may not hold any full-time paid office or employment in City government. Member must represent the cultural arts.	1
Downtown Parking Committee Members must be qualified electors* of the City or County.	2
Harbor Commission Members must be qualified electors* of the City; one member may be a qualified elector of the County.	3
Historic Landmarks Commission Member may be a qualified elector* of the City or non-City resident and meet one of the following qualifications: licensed architect; professional architectural historian; licensed landscape architect; or public at large.	1

Library Board	2
Members must be qualified electors* of the City.	

Neighborhood Advisory Council	4
Members must be residents of the City of Santa Barbara and must be a representative of one of the following neighborhoods: Lower Eastside; Westside; Lower Westside; West Downtown; Laguna; or public at large. Up to three members may be youth ages 16 or 17 residing in one of the specified neighborhoods.	

Parks and Recreation Commission	3**
Qualified electors* of the City.	

**Youth Intern: (non-voting position) one youth intern shall be a high school student volunteer who resides within the Santa Barbara High School District or attends other high schools within the City limits.

Planning Commission	2
Qualified electors* of the City.	

Rental Housing Mediation Board	4
Members may be City or non-City residents and must meet the definition of one of the following specific categories: Landlord Mediator member must own or manage single or multiple residential units; Tenant Mediator member must rent or lease his or her residence and must not own residential property; or Homeowner Mediator must own his or her residence and may not own any other residential property.	
<u>Non-City residents must</u> reside in a jurisdiction which contracts with the Rental Housing Mediation Program for services.	

Santa Barbara Youth Council	6
Members must be between the ages of 13 – 19 years old. Majority of members must be residents of the City. Other members may be residents of the County. Members must be students from the following category: students from a local alternative, community, or continuation high school; student from a local private high school or independent studies; students attending a SBUSD high school; or a student representing the public at large.	

Single Family Design Board	1
Appointees must fit into one of the following categories: licensed architect; possess professional qualifications in fields related to architecture, including but not limited to architecture or landscape architecture, building design, structural engineering, industrial design, urban planning, or landscape contracting; or represent the public at large. Members with professional qualifications must be residents of the County of Santa Barbara; members representing the public at large must be residents of the City of Santa Barbara.
