Building and Fire Code Board of Appeals	2
Members shall be residents of the City or adjoining unincorporated areas of Santa Barbara County and shall demonstrate knowledge and expertise in specialty areas governed by the construction and fire codes of the City.	
Central Coast Commission for Senior Citizens.....	1
Appointee must reside within the City boundaries.	
Citizens' Oversight Committee.....	1
Qualified elector* of the City.	
Community Development and Human Services Committee.....	2
Members must be qualified electors* of the County of Santa Barbara, or employees of the designated organizations. One representative from each of the following specified categories or organizations: Latino Community; Eastside Community.	
Historic Landmarks Commission.....	1
Member may be a qualified elector* of the City or non-City resident and meet one of the following qualifications: licensed architect; professional architectural historian; licensed landscape architect; or public at large.	
Housing Authority Commission	3
Members should have some interest and background in housing development, management, or other comparable experience. One new appointee may be a non-City resident; all members must meet one of the following qualifications: representative of the public at large; tenant who is receiving housing assistance from the Housing Authority; or tenant who is receiving housing assistance from the Housing Authority and is at least 62 years of age or older.	
Neighborhood Advisory Council.....	1
Member must be a resident of the City of Santa Barbara representing the public at large.	
Parks and Recreation Commission	1**
** <u>Youth Intern</u> : (non-voting position) one youth intern shall be a high school student volunteer who resides within the Santa Barbara High School District or attends other high schools within the City limits.	
Rental Housing Mediation Board	2
Members may be City or non-City residents and must meet the definition of the following specific category: Landlord Mediator member must own or manage single or multiple residential units. <u>Non-City residents must</u> reside in a jurisdiction which contracts with the Rental Housing Mediation Program for services.

Santa Barbara Youth Council.....	8
	Members must be between the ages of 13 – 19 years old. Majority of members must be residents of the City. Other members may be residents of the County. Members must be students from the following category: students from a local alternative, community, or continuation high school; students from a local private high school or independent studies; students attending a SBUSD high school; or students representing the public at large.
Single Family Design Board.....	1
	Appointees must fit into one of the following categories: licensed architect; possess professional qualifications in fields related to architecture, including but not limited to architecture or landscape architecture, building design, structural engineering, industrial design, urban planning, or landscape contracting; or represent the public at large. Members with professional qualifications must be residents of the County of Santa Barbara; members representing the public at large must be residents of the City of Santa Barbara.
Sister Cities Board	1
	Member must be a resident of the City.
