

AMENDMENT TO DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY PURCHASE

REFERENCE: Original "Declaration of Emergency Purchase to Santa Barbara Municipal Code § 4.52.080" (executed on or around January 3, 2026) (p.1)

SUBJECT: Amendment to increase the Not-to Exceed (NTE) amount for Quik Response Restoration & Construction (p.2)

The original Declaration of Emergency Purchase is hereby amended as follows, with all other terms and conditions remaining in full force and effect.

1. **SECTION AMENDED:** The paragraph currently reading: "Equipment rented with Sunbelt Rentals in an amount not to exceed \$15,000, and services provided by Stewarts De rooting in an amount not to exceed \$14,000, and Quick Response Restoration and Construction in an amount not to exceed \$170,000 are currently underway (p.1) is deleted in its entirety replaced with the following:

REVISED SECTION: Equipment rented with Sunbelt in an amount not to exceed \$15,000, and services provided by Stewarts De rooting in an amount not to exceed \$14,000, and Quik Response Restoration & Construction in an amount not to exceed \$425,000.00 are currently underway.

2. **JUSTIFICATION:** The increase is necessary to cover the actual scope of work required for the water damage mitigation and microbiological cleaning warranted due to the flood event (p.2). The new estimate covers labor, equipment, and materials for the necessary remediation and clearance procedures (p.3)
