The Project will replace the 70-year-old Vic Trace Reservoir and its associated pump station and connecting pipelines to ensure reliable and safe drinking water for the future.

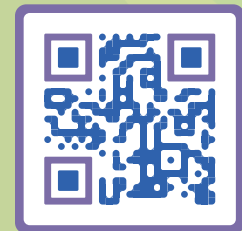
