A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA BARBARA AMENDING THE CITY OF SANTA BARBARA SOLID WASTE IN-PLACE ADDITIONAL CHARGE PER CART FEE

WHEREAS, the City provides, maintains, and operates a variety of programs and services to the public;

WHEREAS, certain sections of the state and municipal code authorize the imposition and collection of fees to defray the costs of providing certain programs and services;

WHEREAS, certain department fee schedules cite the specific state or municipal authority under which fees and charges are collected; and

WHEREAS, due to identified and potential timing conflicts related to public outreach, it is necessary to consider the Solid Waste In-Place Additional Charge (per cart) resolution separately in order to maintain the Fiscal Year 2026 adopted fee for July-August and to establish a new fee effective September 1, 2026, as approved by the City Council on June 30, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA BARBARA THAT:

1. The Council hereby determines and finds that:
 - A. Funds are needed to defray the cost of providing programs and services furnished by the City.
 - B. The funds needed to defray such operating expenses can and should be obtained by setting fees and charges for these programs and services.
 - C. The setting of fees and charges for these programs and services is exempt from compliance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Public Resources Code Section 21080(b)(8)(1)-(4) and Title 14 of the California Administrative Code, Section 15273(a)(1)-(4).
2. The In-Place Additional Charge (per cart) Fee for the Fiscal Year 2027 is adopted as set forth in the Solid Waste Fees section of the City of Santa Barbara Schedule of Penalties, Fees, and Service Charges, attached hereto.
3. The penalties, fees, and service charges contained in the attached schedule shall remain at the Fiscal Year 2026 adopted levels from July 1, 2026, through August 31, 2026, due to timing constraints related to public outreach. Revised fees shall take

effect on September 1, 2026, and remain in effect through June 30, 2027, unless otherwise indicated.

4. All other fee resolutions in effect shall remain in full force.


