PLASTIC



OK to put in

- Empty Beverage & Household Bottles with Caps On
- Buckets
- Large Plastic Tubs
- Empty Laundry Detergent Bottles
- Plastic Flower Pots & Trays
- Plastic Toys
- Rigid Plastics Greater Than 6"

NOT OK to put in

Styrofoam

NEW

NEW

- Plastic Bags & Film Plastic
- Plastic Food Containers (Yogurt, Salsa, Berries, etc.)
- Saran Wrap & Packaging Wrap
- Food Bags & Wrappers
- Plastic Labeled "Compostable" or "Biodegradable"
- Takeout Items: Plastic Straws, Cups, Containers, & Utensils

PAPER & CARDBOARD



OK to put in

- Paper Bags
- Non Waxed Cardboard
- Cereal Boxes & Paperboard
- · Computer & Office Paper
- Envelopes
- Junk Mail
- Newspaper
- Packing & Kraft Paper
- Phonebooks

NOT OK to put in

- Paper Food & Beverage Containers
- Milk Cartons, Tetrapack, & Aseptic Containers
- Pizza Boxes (clean or dirty)
- Waxed Cardboard
- · Napkins & Paper Towels

METAL



OK to put in

- Aluminum Cans
- · Aluminum Foil & Trays
- Caps & Lids From Bottles, Jars & Steel Cans
- Empty Paint Cans
- Empty Spray Cans
- Scrap Metal & Metal Parts

GLASS



OK to put in

- Bottles
- Jars

NOT OK to put in

- Kitchen Glassware & Other Tempered Glass
- · Window Glass

BATTERIES ARE ACCEPTABLE IN A SEALED PLASTIC BAG PLACED ON TOP OF THE RECYCLE CART
