

Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvements on East Cabrillo Boulevard and Union Pacific Railroad Bridge Replacement Project



The City of Santa Barbara and the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments (SBCAG) are proposing the Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvements on East Cabrillo Boulevard and Union Pacific Railroad Bridge Replacement Project (Project). The Project would provide a safe connection for pedestrians and bicyclists through the East Cabrillo corridor and improve vehicular circulation between Los Patos Way and the Highway 101 Interchange at East Cabrillo Boulevard. The Project would also reconfigure the intersection of East Cabrillo Boulevard and Los Patos Way and replace the existing Union Pacific Railroad (UP) Bridge.



PROJECT AREA MAP & PROJECT FEATURES

BENEFITS OF THE PROJECT

- Creates a safe corridor along East Cabrillo Boulevard for pedestrians and bicyclists through the creation of a new bike path, bike lanes, and new sidewalks.
- Reduces traffic congestion and improves mobility by constructing a roundabout at the intersection of East Cabrillo Boulevard and Los Patos Way.
- Provides improved access and connectivity to and from the coastal recreational areas and to the commercial areas along Los Patos Way and Coast Village Road (via the existing Hot Springs Road roundabout).
- Replaces the narrow, existing UP Bridge with a new bridge spanning over a widened roadway with standard lane widths, shoulders, and pedestrian and bicycle facilities. Intersection operations would also be improved with a proposed dedicated right turn lane on eastbound Cabrillo Boulevard for the proposed southbound onramp onto Highway 101.

PROJECT FEATURES


UP Bridge Replacement

The existing single-span UP Bridge over East Cabrillo Boulevard would be replaced by a two-span bridge to accommodate the pedestrian and bicycle improvements.

Improvements on East Cabrillo Boulevard (under the UP Bridge)

The improvements on East Cabrillo Boulevard would provide safe travel under the UP Bridge for pedestrians and bicyclists.

Roundabout at East Cabrillo Boulevard and Los Patos Way

A roundabout at the intersection at East Cabrillo Boulevard and Los Patos Way is proposed to improve vehicular circulation and provide safe and more efficient travel for all users.
