The City needs to select a project by the end of the year to use the last remaining funds allocated from Southern California Edison/CA Public Utilities Commission Rule 20A. PROJECT: The project is located on Cliff Drive from Salida del Sol to San Rafael Avenue and would place all existing overhead wires that supply electric and communication services underground. The poles to be removed are primarily located on the north/mountain side of the street. Affected neighborhood residential overhead utility services would also be placed underground.

LOCATION: Cliff Drive from Salida del Sol to San Rafael Avenue

PROJECT SCHEDULE: Choose a project by the end of the calendar year with the goal of completing construction by 2025.

BENEFITS: Improved ocean views, visual street appearance, and widened pedestrian access.
