**PUBLIC HEARING PROCEDURE:** The following review steps explain the sequence that items undergo during a public hearing: 1. Introduction by the Chair; 2. Staff Comments (optional); 3. Appellant Presentation; 4. Public Comment (if any); 5. Questions from the Board; 6. Comments from the Board; 7. Board Action; and 8. Board Discussion.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** Public comment on matters not listed on the agenda will occur at the beginning of the meeting. Members of the public wishing to speak must submit a speaker slip to staff at the start of the meeting, the Chair will call your name when it is your turn to speak. At that time, you may approach the podium and speak into the microphone. Due to time constraints, individual comments are limited to two minutes. Pooling of time is not allowed during general public comment. The time allotted for general public comment at the beginning of the meeting is 30 minutes. The Board, upon majority vote, may decline to hear a speaker on the grounds that the subject matter is beyond the Board's subject matter jurisdiction.

WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENT: Public comments may also be submitted via email to <a href="mailto:b0ASecretary@SantaBarbaraCA.gov">BOASecretary@SantaBarbaraCA.gov</a> prior to the beginning of the Meeting. All public comments submitted via email will be provided to the Board of Appeals and will become part of the public record. You may also submit written correspondence via US Postal Service (USPS); addressed to BOA Secretary, PO Box 1990, Santa Barbara, CA 93102-1990. However, please be advised, correspondence sent via USPS may not be received in time to process prior to the meeting and email submissions are highly encouraged. Please note that the Board may not have time to review written comments received after 9:00 a.m. on the day of the meeting.

All public comment that is received before 9:00 a.m., the day of the meeting, will be published on the City's website at <u>SantaBarbaraCA.gov/BOA.</u> Comments provided via USPS or e-mail will be converted to a PDF before being posted on the City's website. **Note: comments will be published online the way they are received and without redaction of personal identifying information; including but not limited to phone number, home address, and email address. Only submit information that you wish to make available publicly.** 

**PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDIZED ITEMS:** Members of the public wishing to speak on a matter on the agenda must submit a speaker slip to staff at the start of the meeting, the Chair will call your name when it is your turn to speak. At that time, you may approach the podium and speak into the microphone. State your name and purpose for appearing. Due to time constraints, individual comments are limited to two minutes.
