Survey Analysis

- Clean dataset sent by the Community Formation Commission
- Code any open-ended questions
- Create frequency tables for all survey items

<u>Qualitative Feedback</u>

- Advise Santa Barbara community partners on ways to solicit qualitative feedback through methods such as focus groups or community cafes
- Assist in facilitating virtual feedback sessions
- Analyze qualitative data and identify key themes
