ELECTRONIC PUBLIC COMMENT PROCEDURE: Public comment will occur at the end of the meeting. Oral comments during a meeting may be made by electronic participation only. Pooling of time is not allowed during public comment. The Committee, upon majority vote, may decline to hear a speaker on the grounds that the subject matter is beyond the Committee's subject matter jurisdiction.
