**PUBLIC COMMENT:** At the beginning of the meeting, any member of the public may address the Fire and Police Commission on any subject matter within the jurisdiction of the Fire and Police Commission that is not on the Commission's agenda. The total amount of time for public comments will be 10 minutes, and no individual speaker may speak for more than 2 minutes. Contact Commission Secretaries at least 24 hours in advance to participate in public comment remotely, should a member of the public require an Americans with Disabilities Act accommodation.

**IN-PERSON PUBLIC COMMENT:** A member of the public may address the Fire and Police Commission regarding any scheduled agenda item. Any person wishing to make such address should first complete and deliver a "Request to Speak" form prior to the time that the item is taken up by the Commission.

**REMOTE PUBLIC COMMENT:** Members of the public wishing to make a remote public comment must "raise their hand" in the Zoom Webinar by selecting the virtual hand icon. The keyboard shortcut for this is Alt+Y for Windows and Option+Y for Macs. Staff will activate the speaker's microphone when the speaker's name is called. The speaker will then need to unmute themselves. The keyboard shortcut for this is Alt+M for Windows and Command+Shift+A for Macs.

**WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENT:** Public comments sent via email to <a href="mailto:FPCComments@santabarbaraca.gov">FPCComments@santabarbaraca.gov</a> and received no later than one (1) hour before the meeting will be submitted to the Fire and Police Commissioners and will become part of the public record.

Barbara Andersen announced a proposal for a Daytime Navigation and Workforce Development Center to serve people experiencing homelessness and housing insecurity that will be going before City Council on February 6<sup>th</sup>.

Commissioner Rodriguez spoke to Public Comment received regarding the U.S. Department of Justice Critical Incident Review of the Response to the Mass Shooting at Robb Elementary School in Uvalde, Texas and inquired about the possibility to include this as an agenda item for discussion during a future Fire and Police Commission meeting.

Commissioner Herlinger requested an update on the new Santa Barbara Police Station. Chief Gordon announced that this is already scheduled for a future agenda.
