IN-PERSON PUBLIC COMMENT: A member of the public may address the Fire and Police Commission regarding any scheduled agenda item. Any person wishing to make such address should first complete and deliver a "Request to Speak" form prior to the time that the item is taken up by the Commission.

REMOTE PUBLIC COMMENT: Members of the public wishing to make a remote public comment must "raise their hand" in the Zoom Webinar by selecting the virtual hand icon. The keyboard shortcut for this is Alt+Y for Windows and Option+Y for Macs. Staff will activate the speaker's microphone when the speaker's name is called. The speaker will then need to unmute themselves. The keyboard shortcut for this is Alt+M for Windows and Command+Shift+A for Macs.

WRITTEN PUBLIC COMMENT: Public comments sent via email to <u>FPCComments@santabarbaraca.gov</u> and received no later than one (1) hour before the meeting will be submitted to the Fire and Police Commissioners and will become part of the public record.

Ihab Ghannam is seeking to register Simply Safe Security Co. as a Private Patrol Operator in the City of Santa Barbara.

Per Santa Barbara Municipal Code §5.07, applicants must provide a description of vehicles and uniforms to be used, both of which must be distinctively marked and distinguishable from those used by the Santa Barbara Police Department. The applicant provided all required information and documentation.

On 03/18/2024, I verified that the company's California Private Patrol Operator license was valid. On 03/21/24, a designee of the Chief reviewed the registration materials and signed off on behalf of the Police Department, verifying that the uniforms and vehicles proposed for use in Santa Barbara are distinct from those used by local law enforcement agencies. Only the uniforms indicated herein have been approved for use in the City of Santa Barbara.

The approved uniforms include black cargo pants and a black polo shirt with "Simply Safe Security Company" on the right chest. One shoulder patch is on each arm, and "Security" is in large letters on the back of the shirt. Each badge is gold with "Security" on the top, "Officer" on the bottom, and a golden eagle in the center. There is an optional black jacket with "Security" on the right chest and "Security" in large letters on the back of the jacket.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Santa Barbara Police Department recommends approving Simply Safe Security Co.'s registration as a private patrol operator.


