## **NEW DUTIES & AUTHORITIES OF THE FIRE AND POLICE COMMISSION**

Barbara Andersen, Senior Assistant to the City Administrator, presented new duties and authorities assigned to the Fire and Police Commission regarding civilian oversight of the Police Department and Fire Department. The presentation also included information regarding components of the new Orientation and Training Program as detailed through the adopted Ordinance. Commissioners questions were answered.

## **BROWN ACT TRAINING PRESENTATION**

John Doimas, Assistant City Attorney, presented on the requirements of California's Brown Act as it pertains to Fire & Police Commissioners. The Ralph M. Brown Act training explained who is covered under the Ralph M. Brown Act, what a meeting is, illegal meetings, noticing and agendas, public participation rights, closed sessions, and criminal penalties and civil remedies. The ethics training explained ethics laws on personal financial gain, perquisites of office, transparency, and fair process.
