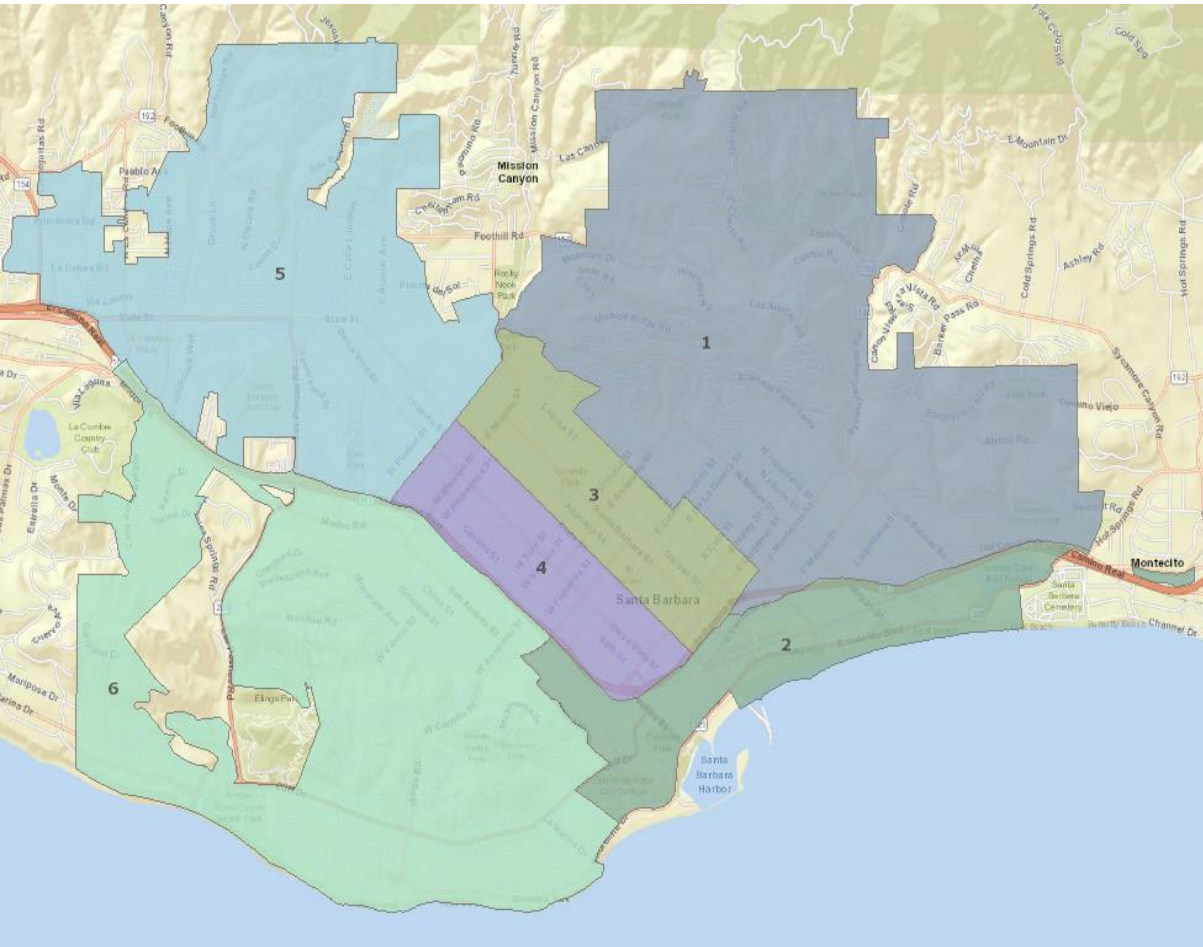

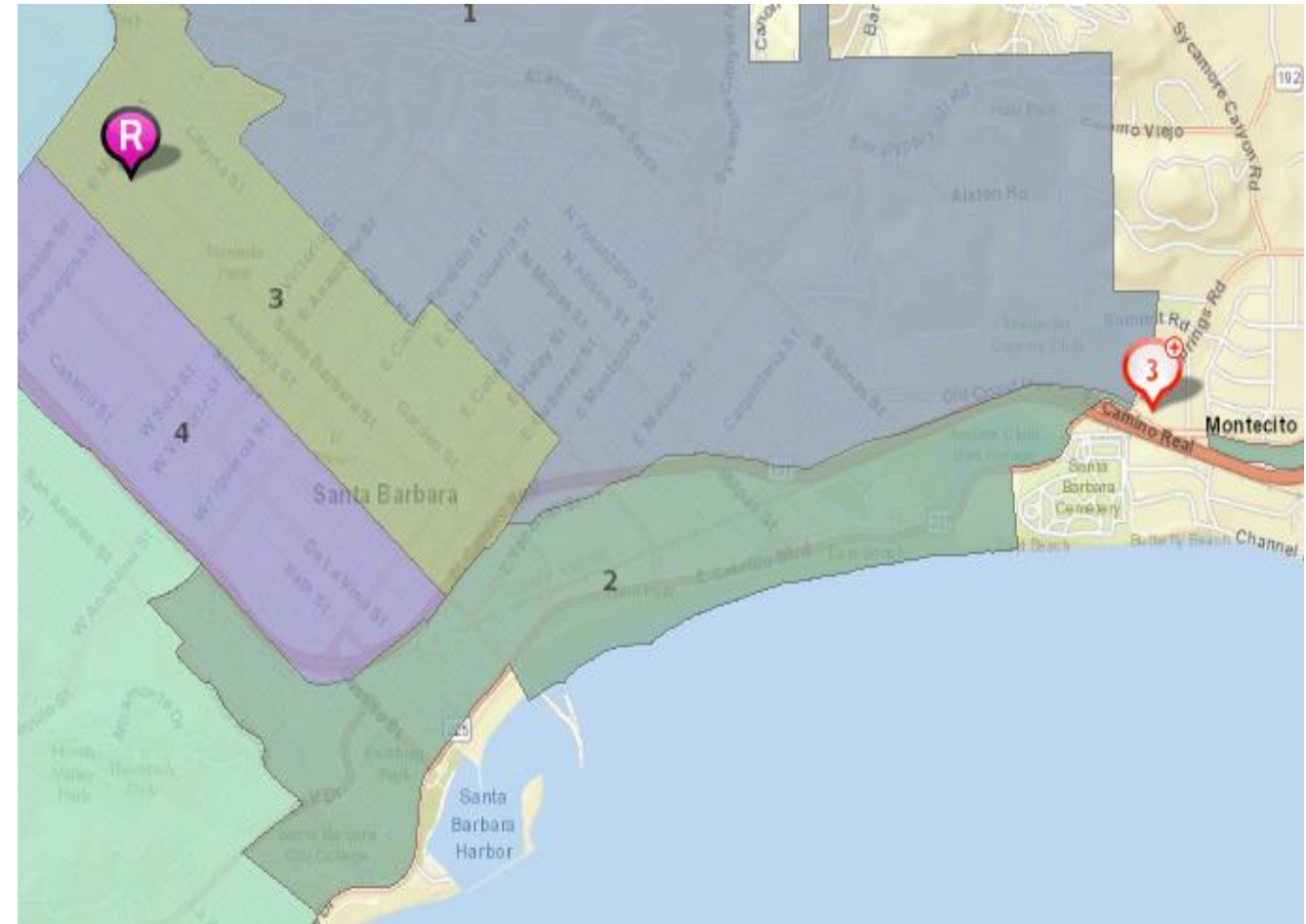

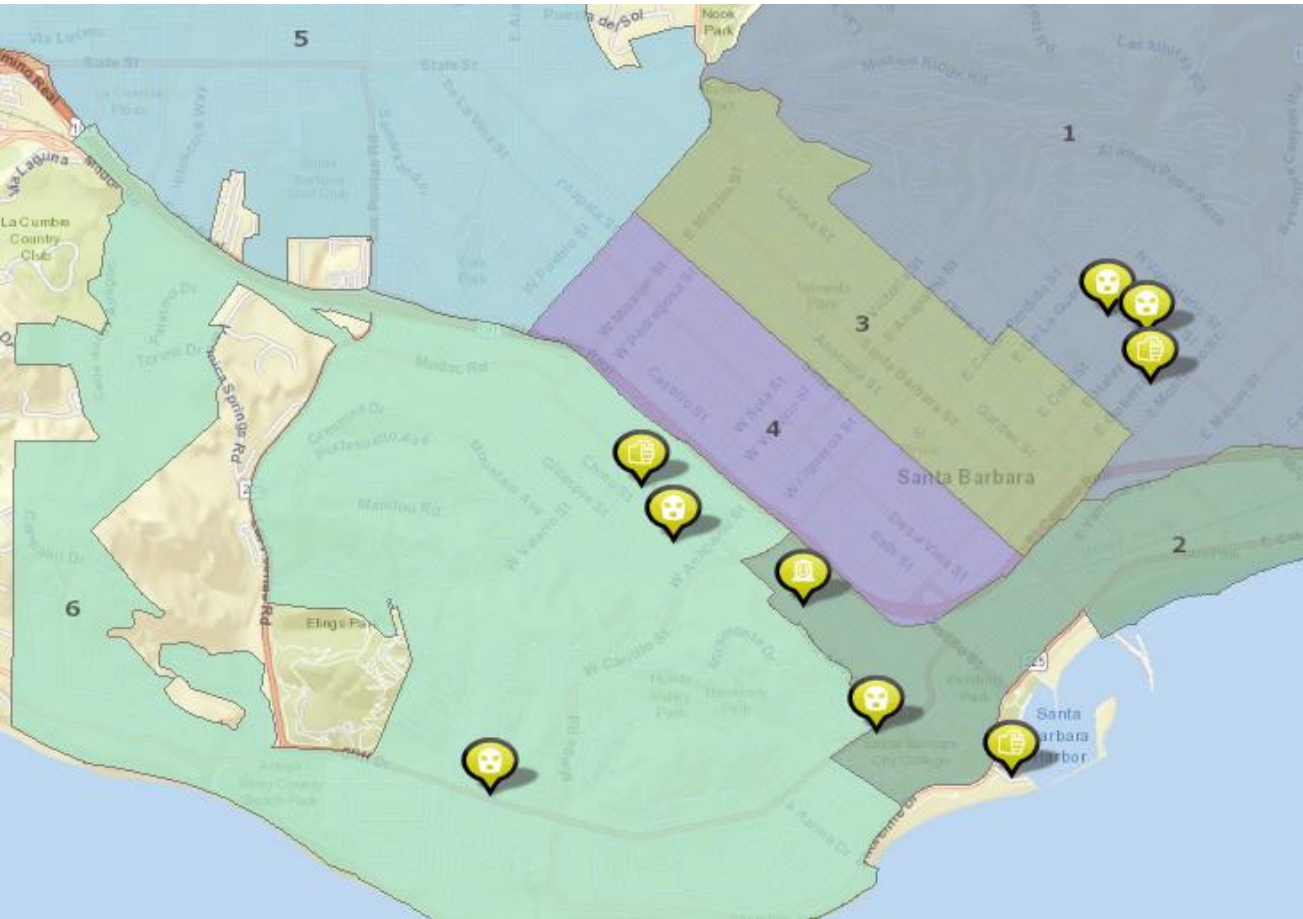

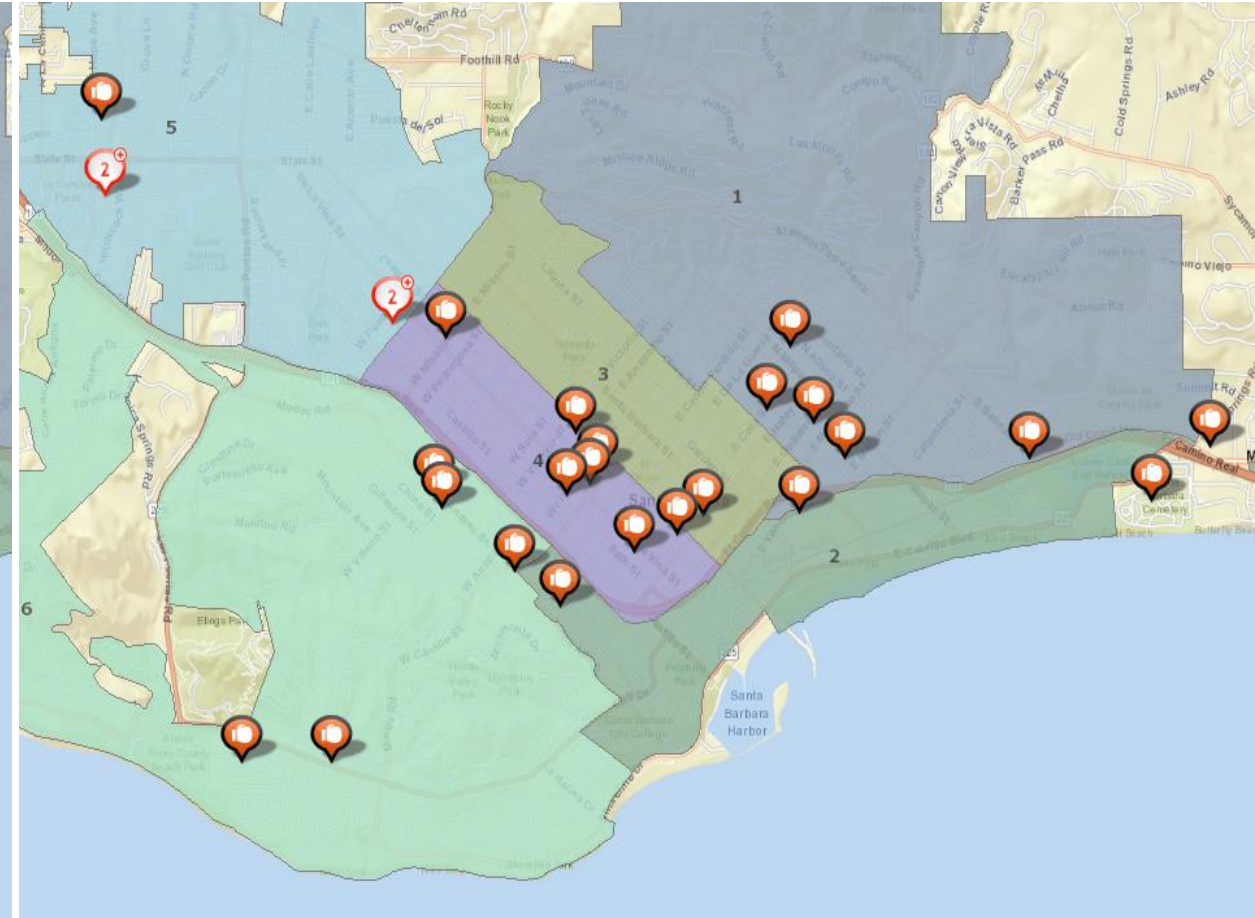

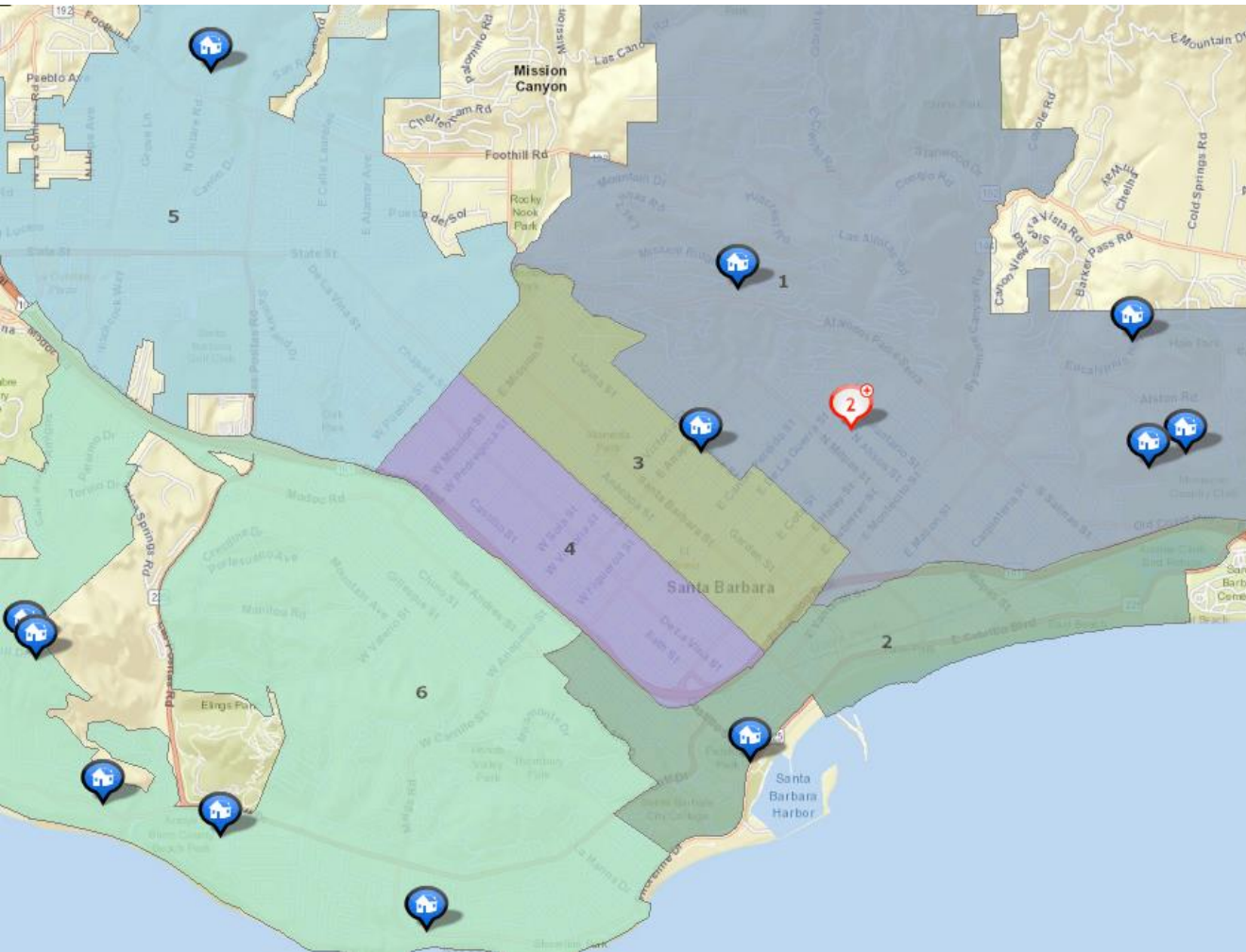

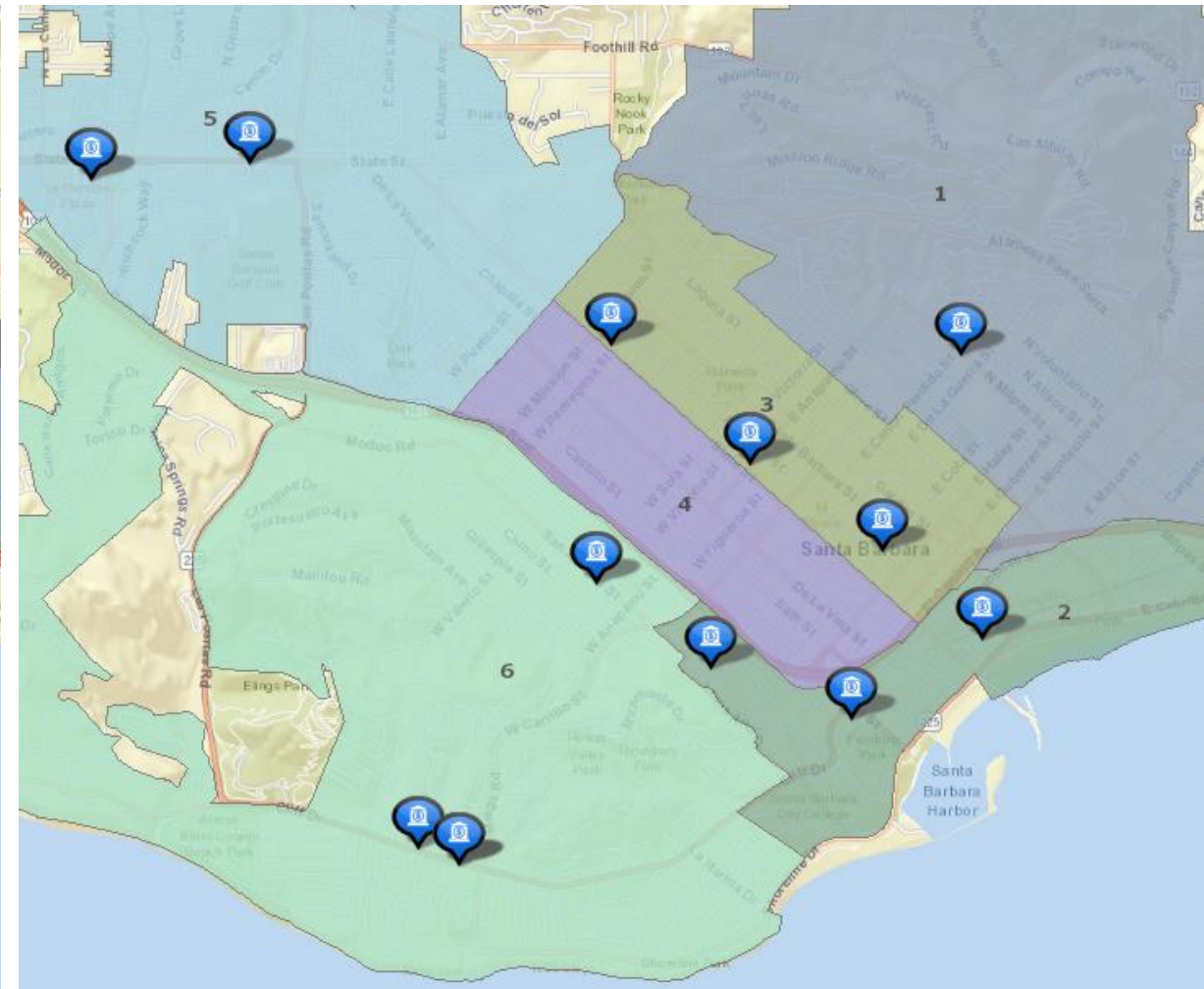

Residential Burglaries



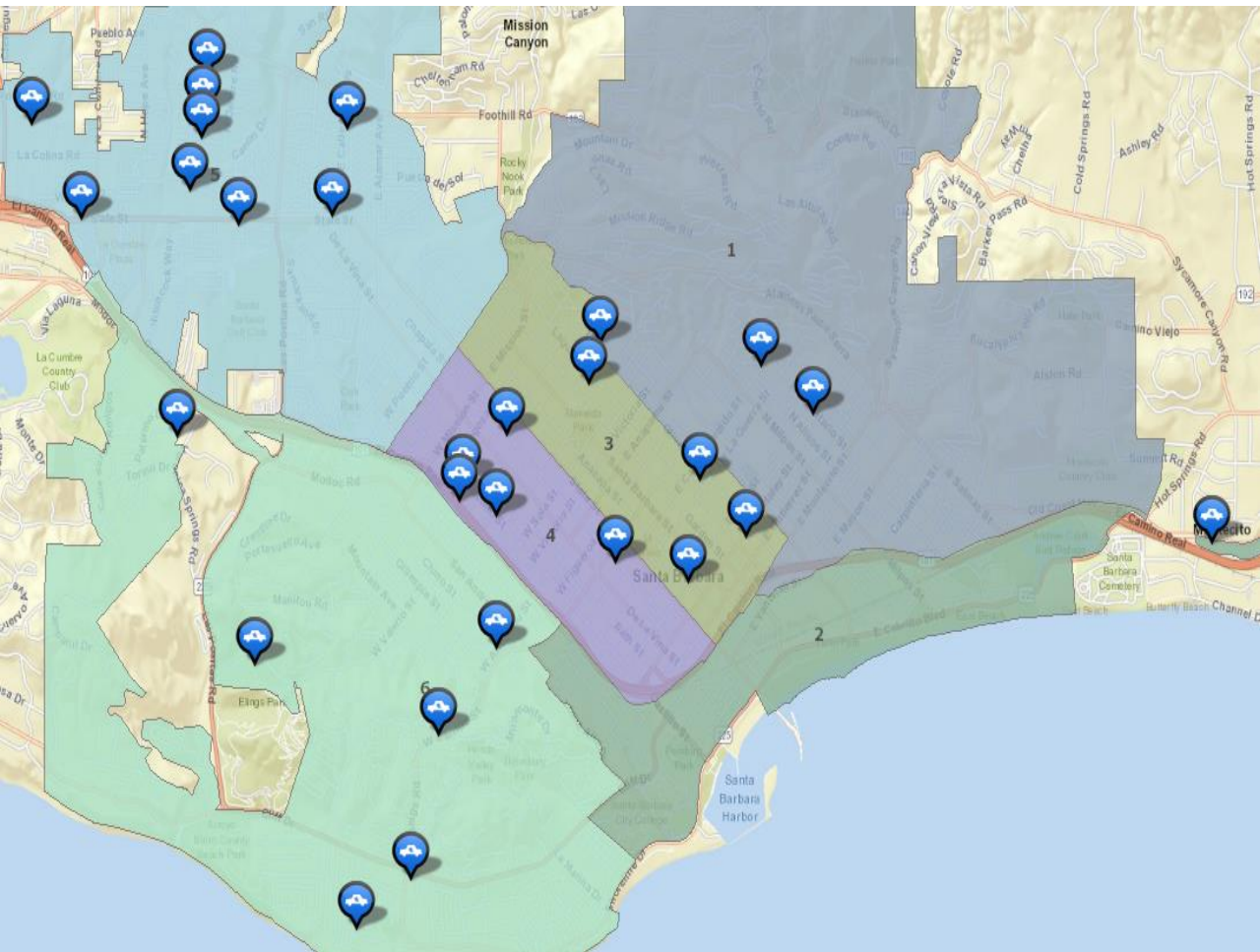
Commercial Burglaries



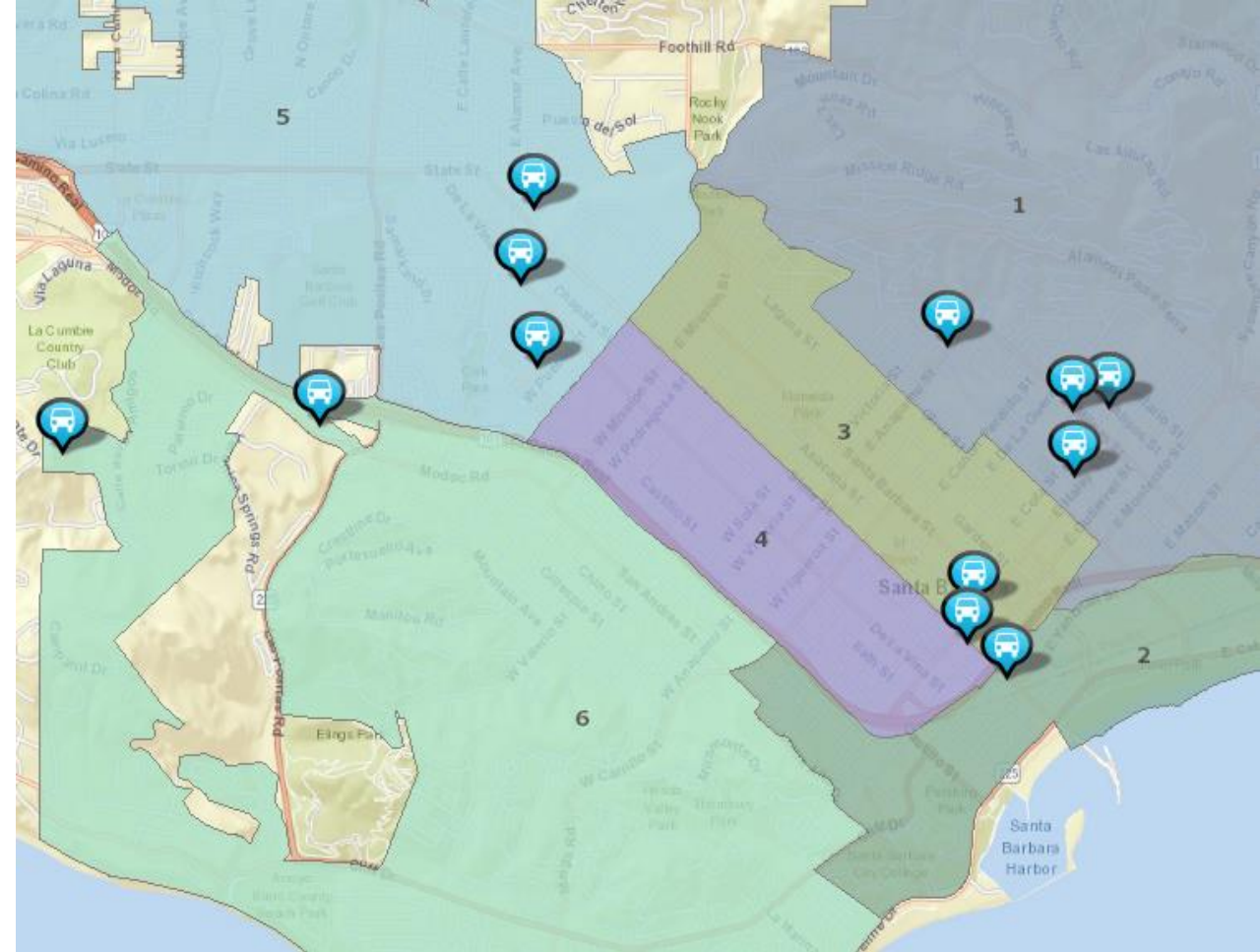

Burglary/Theft from Vehicle



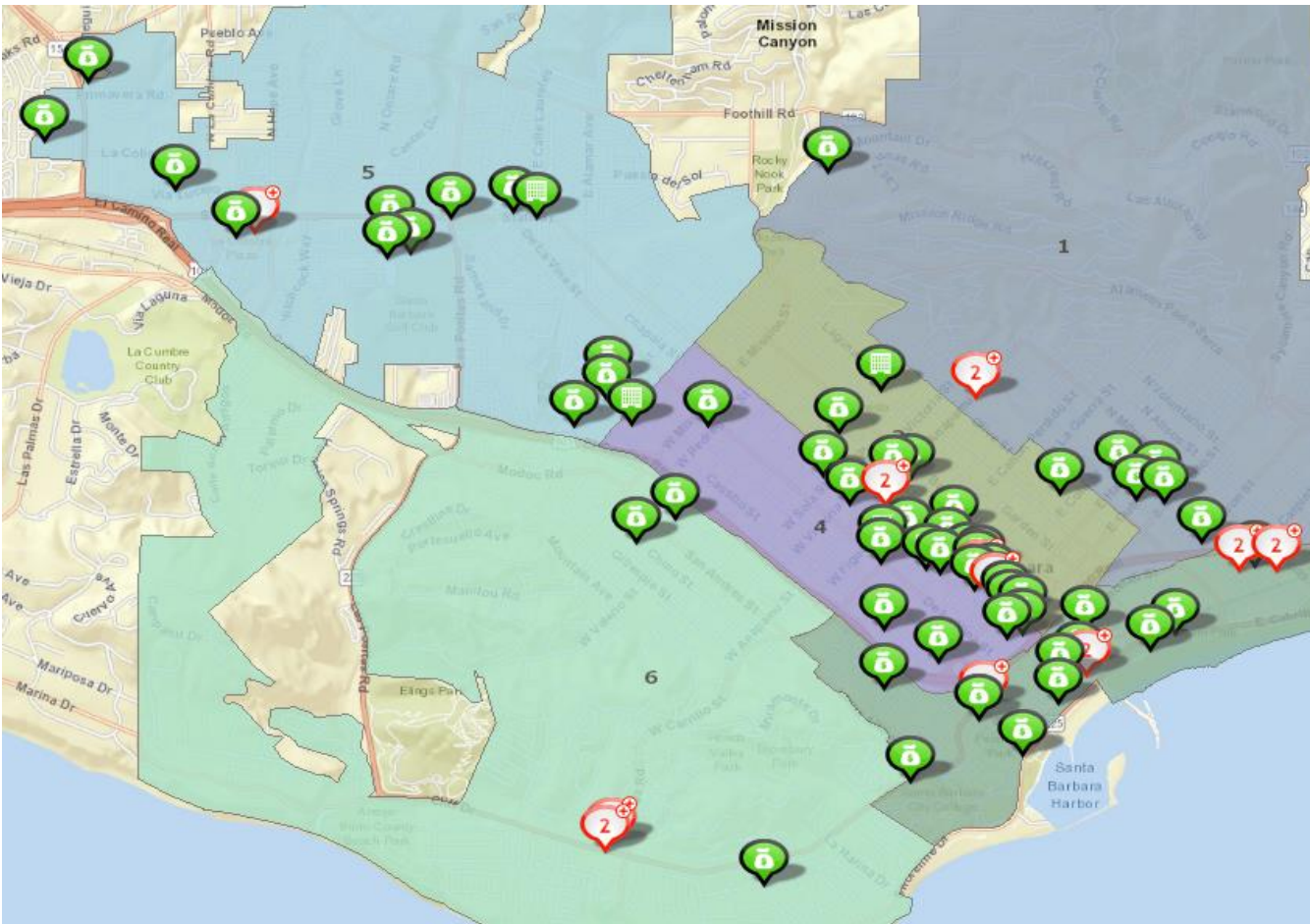

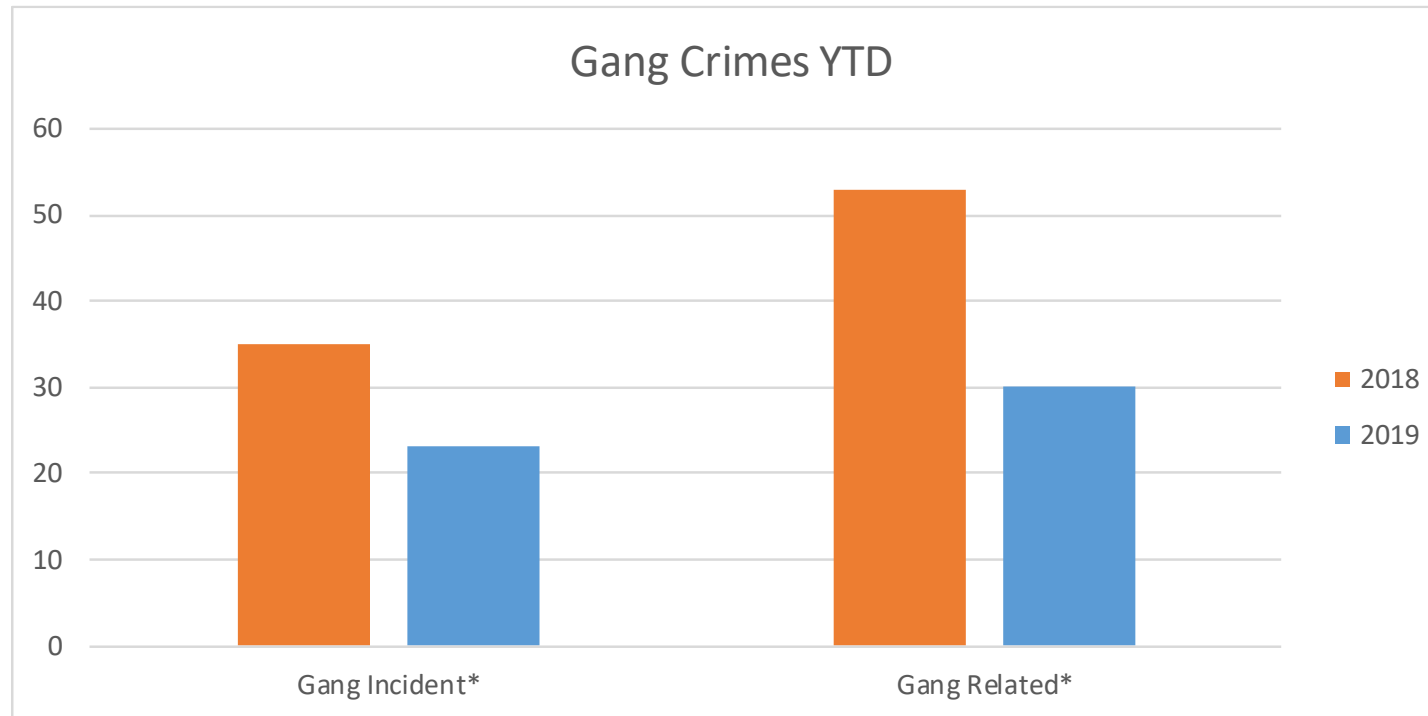

Pedestrian TC

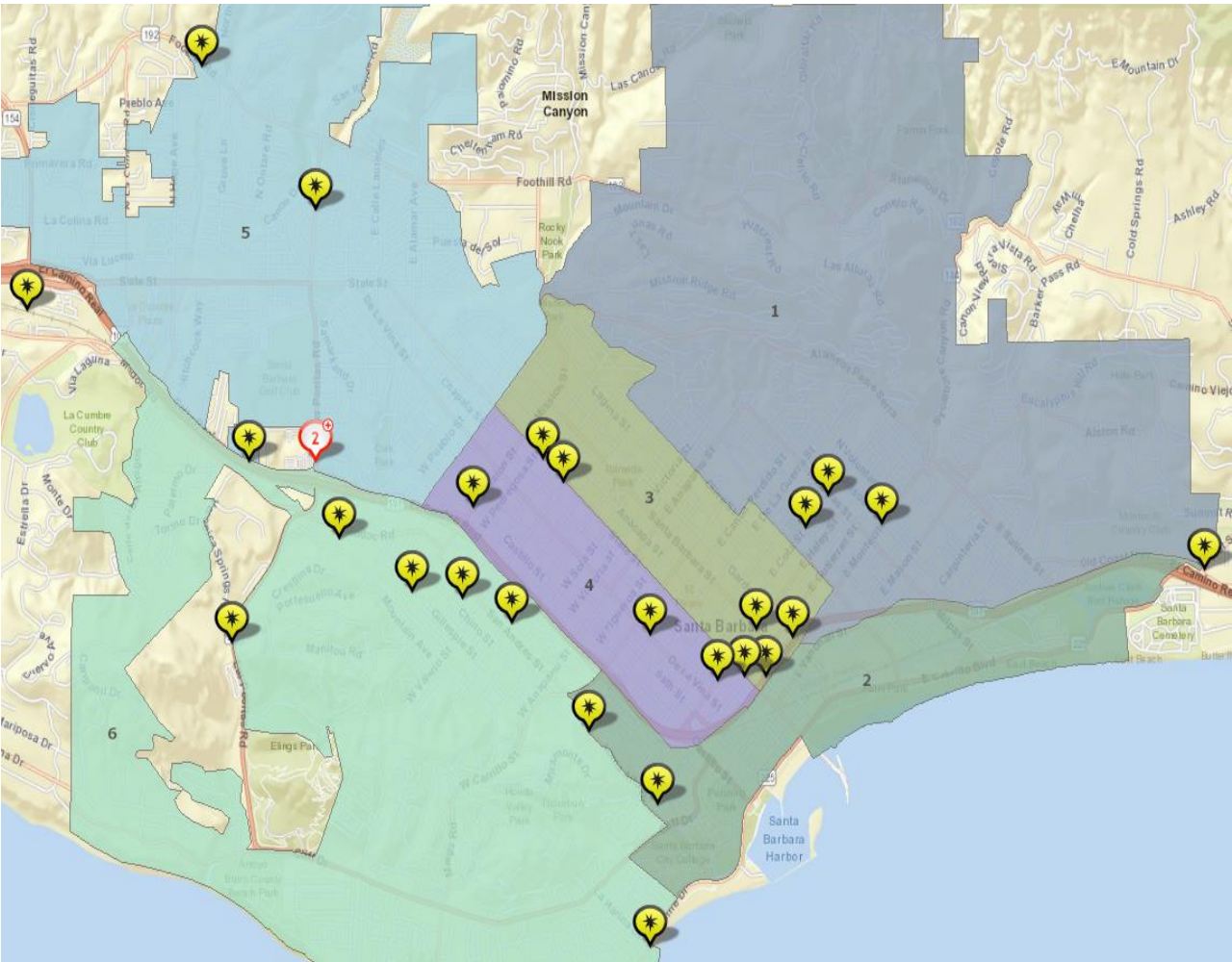


Bicycle TC

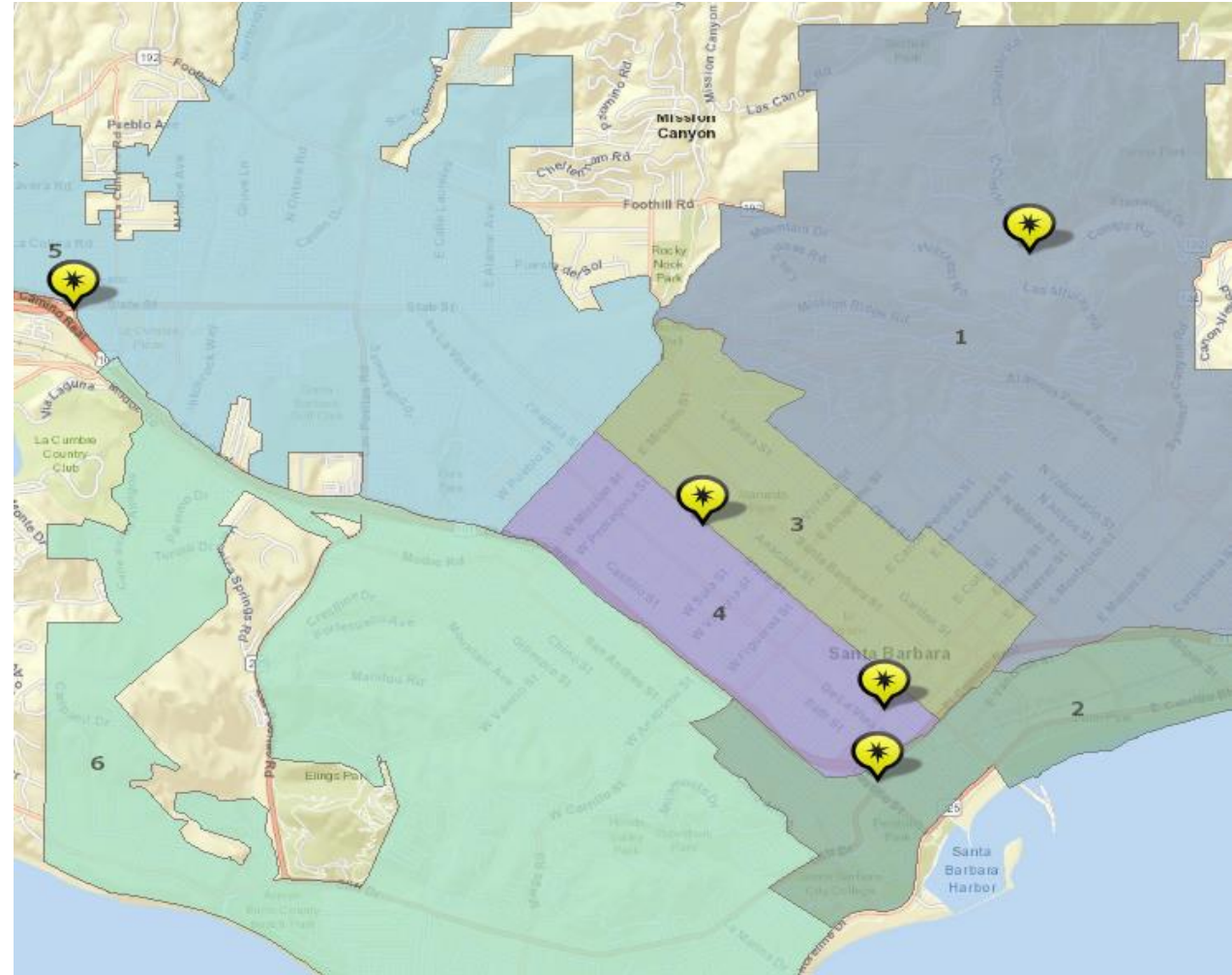
