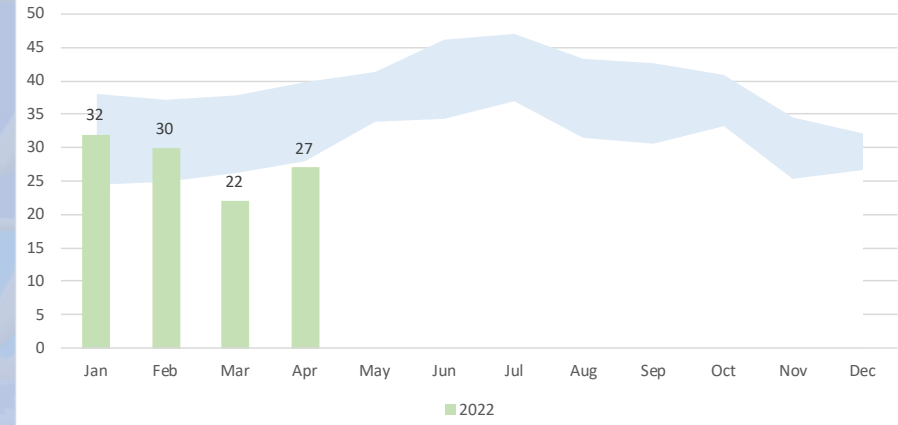
## 2022 Crimes Compared to Average Range of Last 5 Years



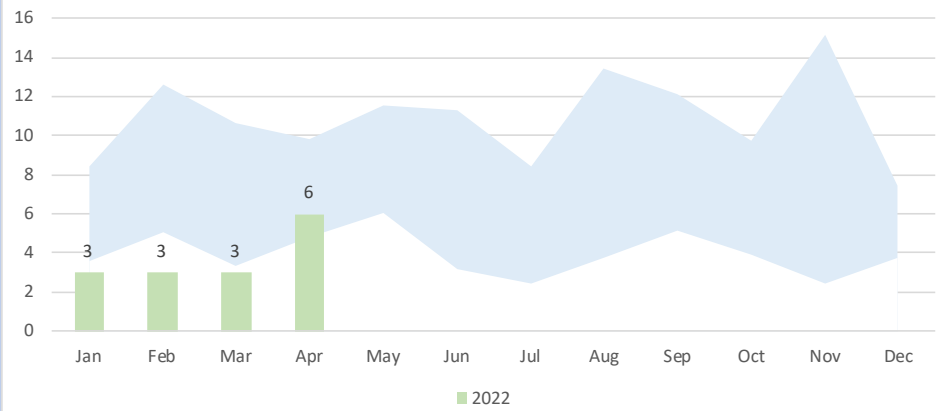
2022 Comparision to Avg Range of Last 5 Years

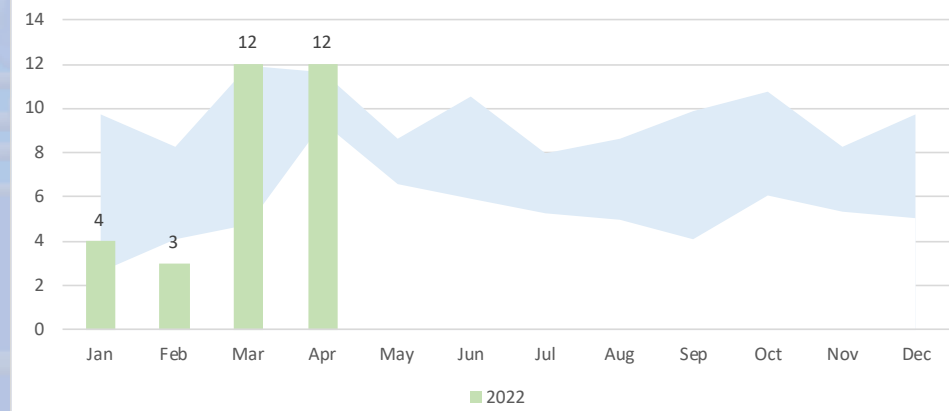
2022 Comparision to Avg Range of Last 5 Years  
Aggravated Assault



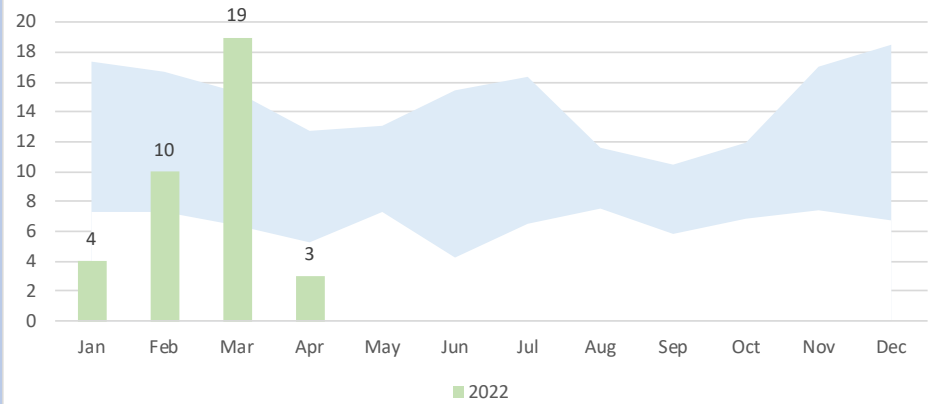
2022 Comparision to Avg Range of Last 5 Years  
Rape



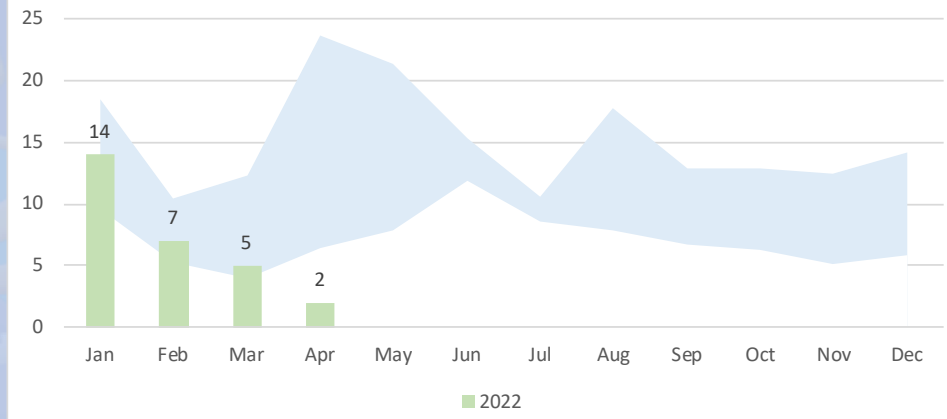
2022 Comparision to Avg Range of Last 5 Years  
Robbery



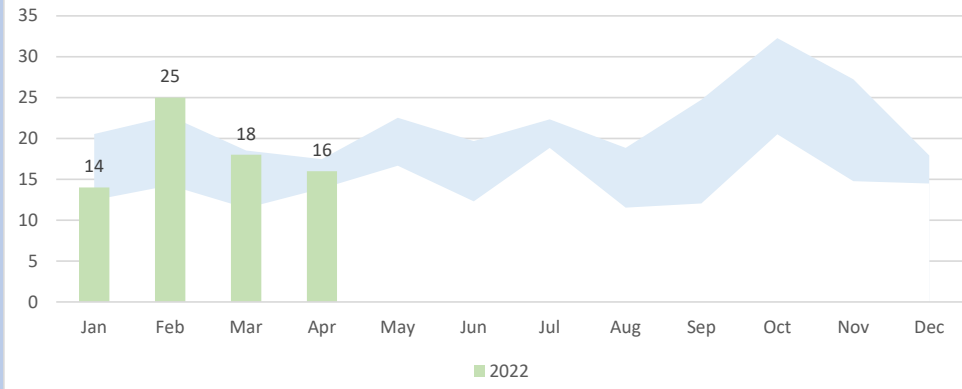

Residential Burglary



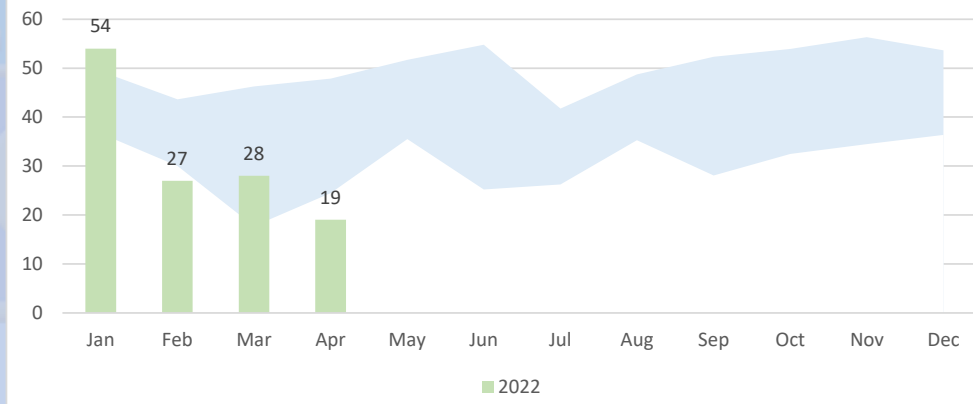

Commerical Burglary



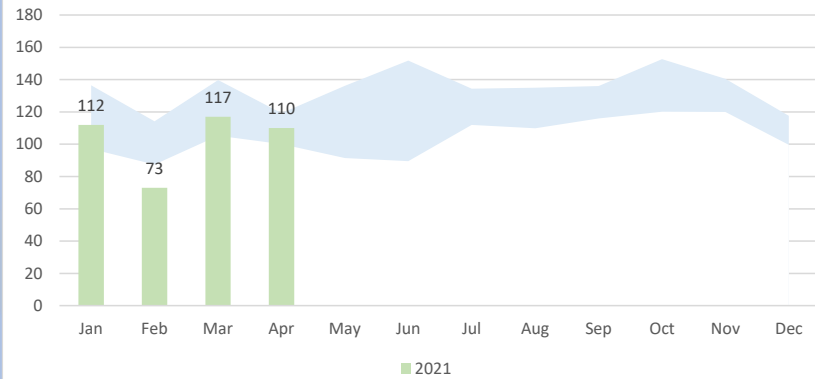

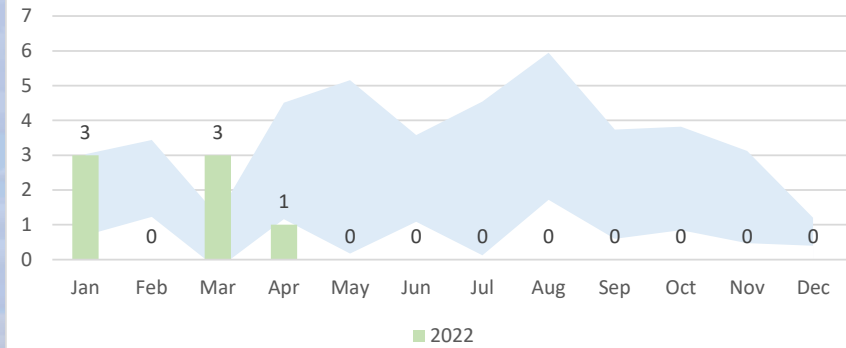
2022 Comparison to Avg Range of Last 5 Years
