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Barbara Cornwall is seeking to register Cornwall Security Services, Inc. as a Private Patrol Operator in the City of Santa Barbara.

Per Santa Barbara Municipal Code §5.07, applicants must provide a description of vehicles and uniforms to be used, both of which must be distinctively marked and distinguishable from those used by the Santa Barbara Police Department. The applicant provided all required information and documentation.

On 03/06/2024, I verified that the company's California Private Patrol Operator license was valid. On 03/18/24, a designee of the Chief reviewed the registration materials and signed off on behalf of the Police Department, verifying that the uniforms and vehicles proposed for use in Santa Barbara are distinct from those used by local law enforcement agencies. Only the uniforms indicated herein have been approved for use in the City of Santa Barbara.

The approved uniforms consist of black cargo pants and a white button-up shirt. One shoulder badge on each arm, the badge is red with the company name and "Private Security" on the bottom. It also includes the company logo (a red lion) in the center. There is an optional black jacket with two shoulder badges and a gold metal badge on the left chest. A "Security" badge is in large letters on the right chest, and "Security" is in large letters on the back of the jacket.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

On September 19, 2012, Governor Brown signed Senate Bill 1186 (SB 1186) into law. 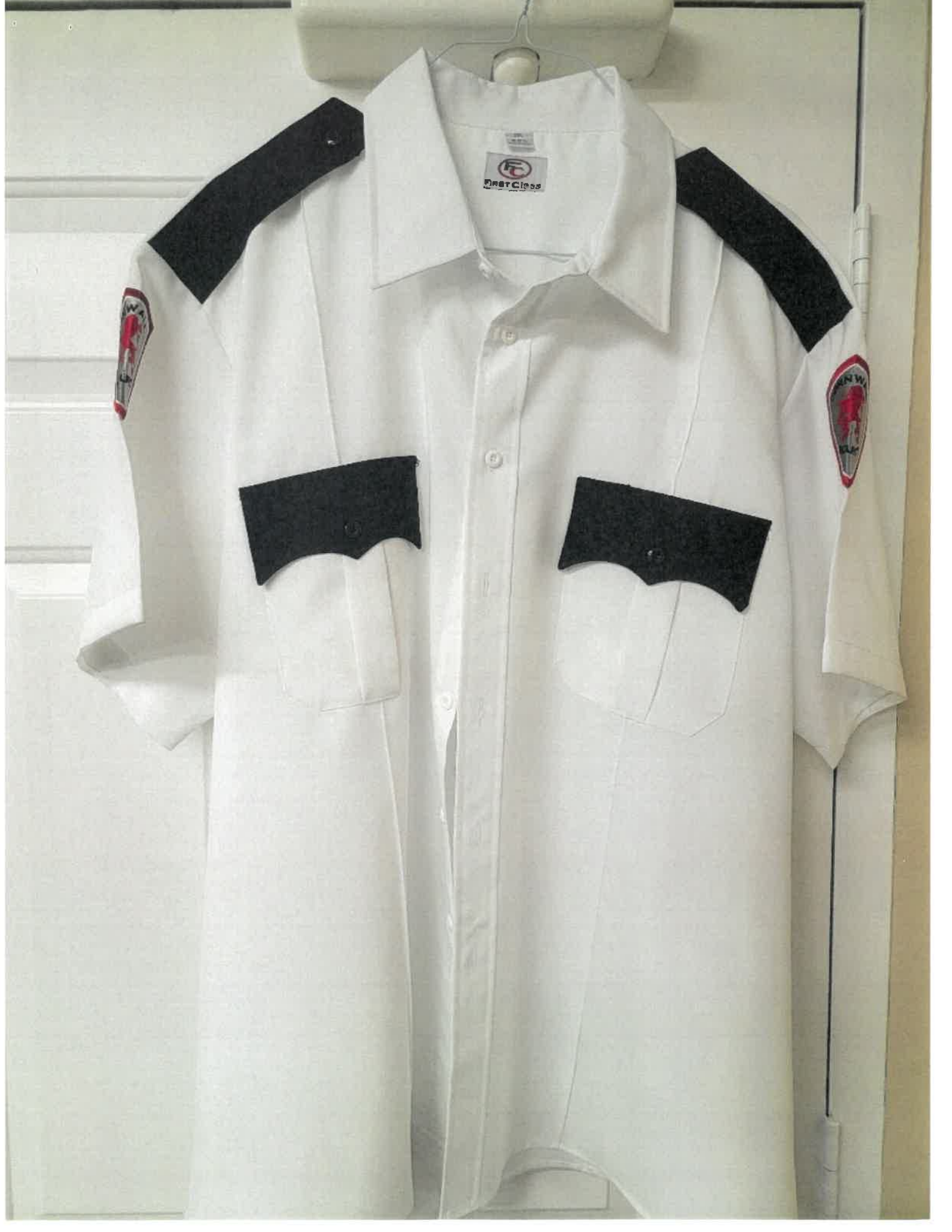

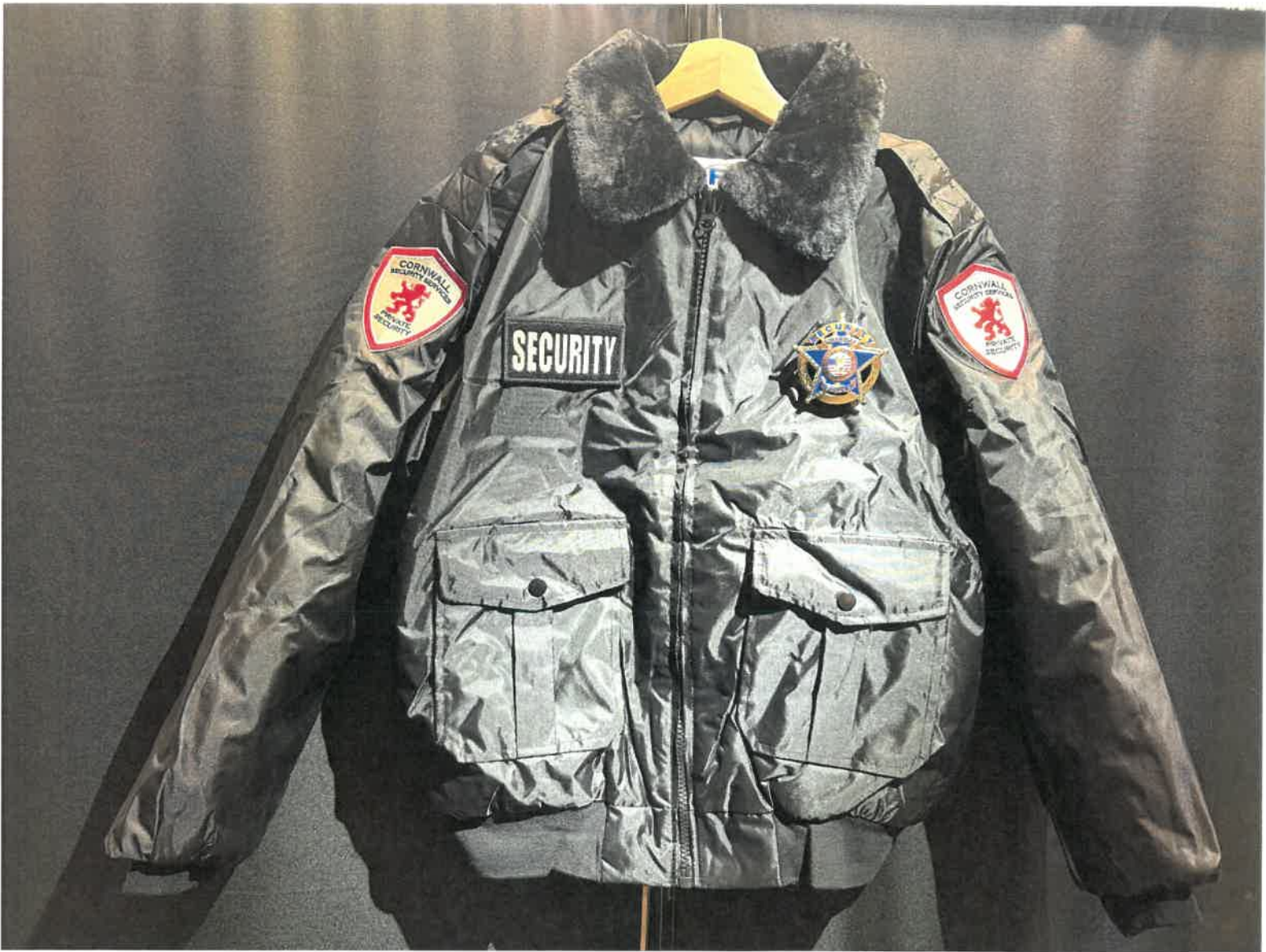

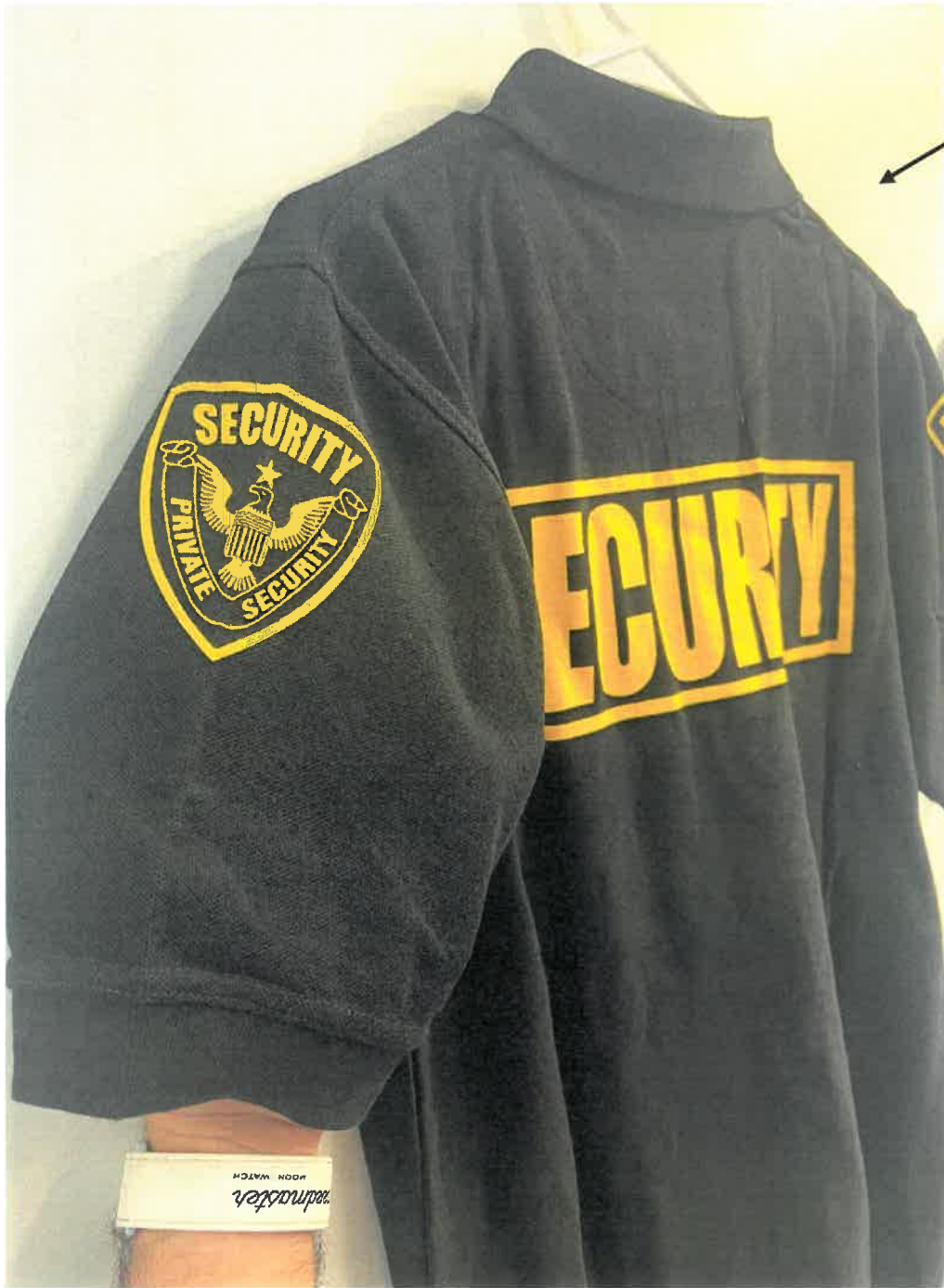

On September 19, 2012, Governor Brown signed Senate Bill 1186 (SB 1186) into law.
