### 2. Golf Course Performance

Tina Nelson provided an overview of the financial performance of the golf course. Through the end of May 2023, 97% of the budget for Fiscal Year 2023 (FY23) has been achieved. Financial performance is within 1% (\$47K) of Fiscal Year 2022 (FY22).

Randy Shannon provided an overview of recent events and presented information on events on the calendar thought out the summer such as the US Open event on 6/17/23, Taylor Mad and Calloway fitting days, Golf Camps and the SB Golf Classic scheduled for August 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>.

#### 3. Golf Course Maintenance Report

Scott Walwyn updated the committee on maintenance projects. The Bunker Project for FY23 has been completed. One green side Bunker remains to be renovated and will be done when the Number 13 Green is reconstructed. Thirty-Five Trees are being planted the week of June 19<sup>th</sup> as part of the reforestation project that will take place over the next several fiscal years. A portion of the fence that was knocked down by a fallen tree during a storm event next to hole 17 is being repaired, irrigation repairs have been completed and preparation for the golf classic in early August is under way. Lastly Scott shared that a new mechanic has been hired and is performing well to date.

The Committee received reports from the Home Club representatives regarding club activity and feedback from various members.
