D. Announcements, requests by applicants for continuances and withdrawals, future agenda items, and appeals:

1. Ms. Reidel announced the following:

- a. The June 19, 2024 Historic Landmarks Commission (HLC) meeting is cancelled in observation of Juneteenth. The July 3, 2024 HLC meeting is cancelled in observation of the Independence Day. There will be a special HLC meeting on June 26, 2024. Consent will take place at 11:00 a.m. as usual and Full Commission will take place at 12:30 p.m.
- b. The Pearl Chase Society is hosting an event on Friday, June 7, 2024 at 5:30 p.m. at Alhecama Theatre on preserving architecture in Santa Barbara and different perspectives on approaching Santa Barbara History.
- 2. Ms. Hernandez announced the following:
 - a. Nathan Slack, Urban Forest Superintendent, provided a tentative schedule for the Doremus Stone Pines. A discussion will come to HLC on July 17, 2024. The item will then go to the Street Tree Advisory Committee (STAC) on August 1, 2024. On August 28, 2024 Parks and Recreation Commission (PRC) will have a discussion on replanting the East Anapamu corridor. After the PRC discussion a memo will be sent to HLC with the modified decisions which will allow new trees to be planted in the fall. On September 5, 2024 the item will go back to STAC. PRC is the final decision maker to vote on approved designation changes.

(Designated a Structure of Merit, designed in 1953 by architects Reisner & Urbahn. Proposal for conversion of the existing 14,494-square-foot building to a new community health clinic on a 2.57-acre site located at the southeast corner of State Street and Las Positas Road. Proposal includes demolition of 901 square feet of building area, and construction of a 9,739-square-foot two-story addition, 103 parking spaces, solar panel carports, landscaping, replacement of original windows, and public improvements. The project was designated a Community Benefit Project by the City Council. The HLC accepted the Historic Structures/Sites Report Phase 1 on November 9, 2022 and Phase 2 accepted on July 11, 2023. Project received Development Plan approval by the Planning Commission, and General Plan Amendment and Specific Plan approval by the City Council.)

Project Design Approval is requested. Project Compatibility Findings and Major Alteration Findings are required. Project last reviewed on July 12, 2023.
