Materials related to an item on this agenda submitted to the Independent Redistricting Commission after distribution of the agenda packet are posted to the City's website as soon as reasonably feasible.

PUBLIC COMMENT: At the beginning of each meeting of the Independent Redistricting Commission, any member of the public may address the Commissioners concerning any item not on the Commission's agenda. Any person wishing to make such address should first complete and deliver a "Request to Speak" form prior to the time that public comment is taken up by the Commission. Each speaker will be given a total of 3 minutes to address the Council.
