 We are requesting to remove a Pine Tree at 1212 Punta Gorda in front of unit 18.  
 A. That principles of good forest management will best be served by the proposed removal;  
 We offer to replace the tree with two or three replacement trees anywhere in town the commission suggests. This removes the burden of responsibility from the city on this looming accident waiting to happen.  
 B. That a reasonable and practical development of the property on which the tree is located requires removal of the tree or trees whose removal is sought;  
 The owner and park are planning to replace the old mobile home with a new one and the tree is in the way of placing the new home. The roots are lifting the home and will eventually damage the water and sewer infrastructure of the home and park. The tree could potentially fall on power/communication lines with the tree being so close to the street pole.  
 C. That the character of the immediate neighborhood with respect to forestation will not be materially affected by the proposed removal;  
 We have checked with the immediate neighborhood and all agreed the tree is out of place. It is posing a danger to neighbors and is creating a mess with sap on the house, patio and parked cars.  
 D. That topography of the building site renders removal desirable;
