The 1,048-square-foot lot is currently developed with a two-story mixed-use building comprised of a 645-square-foot commercial retail space on the first floor and a 748-square-foot residential unit on the second floor; the building is part of a series of commercial storefronts (131-137 East De La Guerra Street) constructed in 1927 in the Spanish Colonial Revival style and designated as a Structure of Merit. The project involves a new ABC license (Type 20) for The Eddy, a

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specialty food store at the corner of East De La Guerra Street and Santa Barbara Street. The Type 20 license allows the store to sell wine and beer for off-site consumption under the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act. No exterior changes are proposed.

The discretionary application under the jurisdiction of the Planning Commission at this hearing is:

Α. A Conditional Use Permit to allow for off-site sale of alcoholic beverages with a Type 20 license under the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act (SBMC §30.185.075 & SBMC §30.215)

Confirm the Environmental Analyst's determination that the project is exempt from further environmental review pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15301 [Existing Facilities], and SBMC Chapter 22.100.
