2023 Crimes Compared to Average Range of Last 5 Years

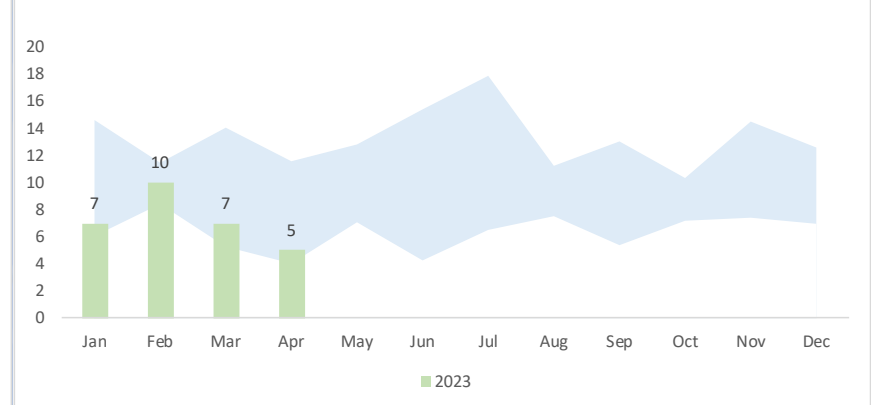




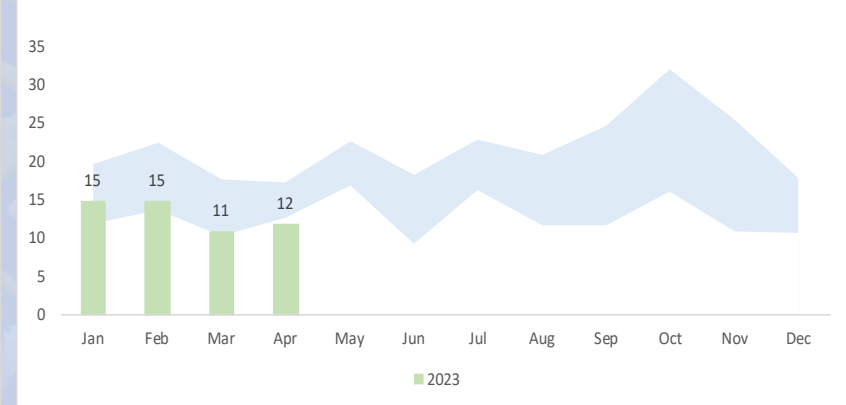
2023 Comparision to Avg Range of Last 5 Years
Commerical Burglary



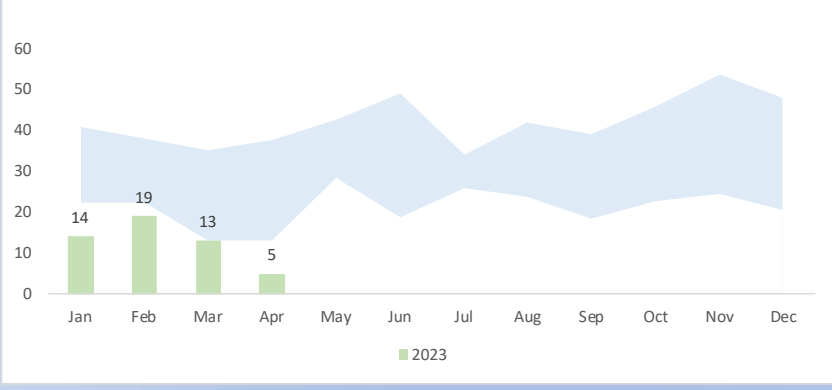
2023 Comparision to Avg Range of Last 5 Years
Residential Burglary



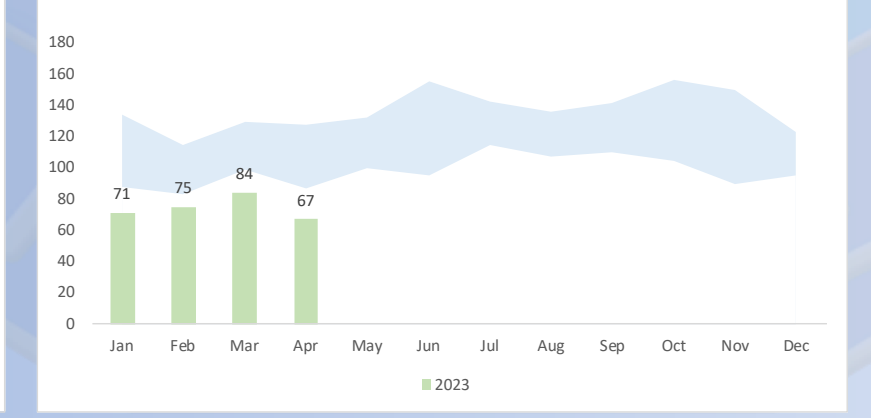

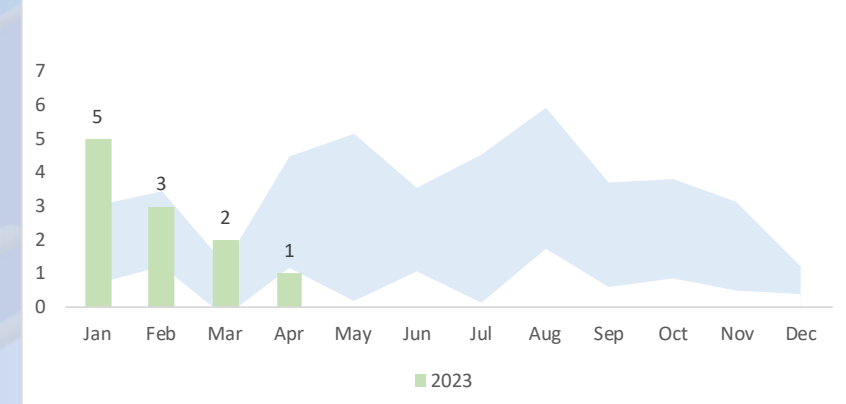
