1. Coordination with the Santa Barbara Half Marathon on Sunday – For Discussion

Recommendation: Staff will present information on the Santa Barbara Half Marathon that will take place on Sunday, November 6, 2022 that will require coordination similar to the 2021 event. Open item to public comment; bring back to Committee for Discussion

2. Review rules for Cottage Food members – For Discussion

Recommendation: The Cottage Food membership category was created at a time when the Show was segregated between Arts and Crafts Sections. The rule was written to only allow Cottage Food members to participate in the East section of the show. Staff is requesting input on this topic if this category should be integrated or if Cottage Foods should be restricted to only participate in East-designated spaces. Open item to public comment; bring back to Committee for Discussion
