Youth Council Members discussed the necessity of creating two standing subcommittees to aid in the preparation of Youth Speak Out. One subcommittee to address marketing for Youth Council events and one subcommittee to plan the event outline for Youth Speak Out.

It was moved and seconded by Youth Council members Flanagin and Hellman respectively, to approve the creation of a standing Marketing Subcommittee and a Youth Speak Out planning subcommittee.

Youth Council presented results from the survey sent out to friends and other youths relating to Mental Health and Mental Wellness topics. Youth Council members would like to focus on the following topics under Mental Wellness: body positivity, self-confidence, coping with personal mental health experiences, balancing school and social life, and physical wellness. Youth Council created a task list and set meeting times for future subcommittee meetings relating to the organization and planning for Youth Speak Out.
