Youth Council members discussed the Harriet Miller Youth Leadership Award, with some members recalling their experience with reading through submissions. Youth Council members suggested that the subcommittee be made of four members rather than three.

It was moved and seconded by Youth Council members Solano Beltran and Vander May respectively, to approve recommendation with an amendment to have a four person ad hoc subcommittee consisting of members Suresh, Vander May, Chenoweth, and Solano Beltran.

3. Subject: Youth Speak Out – For Discussion

Youth Council separated into two groups, the first decided table topics and the second group discussed promotion for the event. Both groups agreed to do work on both tasks individually and reconvene for another break out group during the next special meeting.
