## **REPORTS**

### **5. Safe Routes to School Program Update**

Recommendation: That the Transportation and Circulation Committee (TCC) receive an update on the Safe Routes To School (SRTS) Program efforts in the City of Santa Barbara.

Sam Furtner, Mobility Coordinator, and Kim Stanley Zimmerman with MOVE SBC (formerly SBBike+COAST) provided an overview of SRTS Program and the educational services MOVE SBC provides.

**COMMITTEE COMMENTS:** Committee Member Rodriguez expressed safety concerns with ~~e-bikes being used by youth~~ rapid cycling on e-bikes near pedestrians. Committee Member Horne suggested distribution of bells and helmets with lights to bicyclists – she also mentioned lack of safe bike parking.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** None.

## **PROGRAM UPDATES**

6. **State Street Promenade Update:** Downtown Team Manager, Brian Bosse, provided an update on the State Street Promenade.

**COMMITTEE COMMENTS:** Vice Chair Blackerby expressed the need to do additional outreach to the community regarding the State Street Master Plan. Committee Member Rodriguez raised her concerns about a consultant doing the work without input. Mr. Bosse

advised that the State Street Master Plan will involve many opportunities for community input. Committee Member Horne commented that input should be received **by from** public **as well**, rather than solely **from** business owners. Mr. Bosse clarified that the larger Master Plan process will involve collecting citizen/resident input from all areas of the city through many avenues.

7. **Active Transportation Program:** Supervising Transportation Planner, Jessica Grant, provided an update on the Active Transportation Program (ATP) funding and projects.
8. **Measure A Cycle 5:** Mrs. Grant provided an update the Measure A Cycle 5 Grants. The city was approved for three out of five applications including the Modoc Multiuse Path Extension, San Andres Safe Crossings and Lighting, and the Santa Barbara Junior High Multiuse Path on Cota Street.

**COMMITTEE COMMENTS:** Committee Member Rodriguez expressed her excitement for the Modoc Multiuse Path Extension Project.
